#4. Pentecost (Day of Firstfruits)	Israel at Mount Sinai	Filling of Spirit, Christian's Empowerment for Service	New Testament Pentecost (Rapture of Firstfruits)
#5. Rosh Hashanah (Feast of Trumpets)	Tabernacle Built	Gathering Together for Worship, Witnessing, Christian Fellowship	Rapture of Church (Main Harvest)
