Prologue



Back in 1986, my wife Cindy wanted to place a bumper sticker on our car that read: *Jesus Is Coming Soon*. I remember telling her not to do it because we don't know when He is coming. Being the humble, dutiful wife that she is, she did not argue with me but decided to pray for me.

Cindy's prayers were soon answered when Edgar Wisenant appeared on the scene with his books: *On Borrowed Time* and *The Rapture: Rosh-Hash-Ana 1988 And 88 Reasons Why*. After reading Edgar's books I humbly apologized to my wife and asked her to please forgive me for being so ignorant. I spent the next two years pouring over Edgar's entire voluminous research notes and after his failed prediction I began intently studying the subject of prophecy. Prophecy Countdown was born as Cindy and I began writing our monthly newsletter to a growing number of hungry believers desiring to be looking for the Blessed Hope (Titus 2:11-13) of our Lord's return.

Earlier this year we republished Lyn Mize's wonderful book: *The Open Door*. We believe his excellent resource can be instrumental in helping believers qualify to become part of the called, and chosen, and faithful (Rev 17:14) who will be granted the magnificent opportunity to reign and rule with Jesus when He returns very soon. The same week that it was introduced on A mazon we found another important new book entitled: *Witnessing The End – Daniel's Seventy Sevens and the Final Decree Everyone Missed*. Written by Dr. Christian Widener who has uncovered one of the final pieces to the puzzle, which will help us discover when Christ may return.

Regardless of what you know about Bible Prophecy, his book will totally shock you. If you have an open mind and a teachable heart his book can help you realize how close our Lord's return really is. This book: *The Final Countdown* is being produced to help condense his findings and summarize the essential details to reach more of the Church with his vital message.

A key to understanding the prophecy in Daniel 9 is to realize that the Seventy Weeks were fulfilled at Christ's first coming. This is known as the Messianic View and it is well summarized in Chapter 4 and Appendix 4 in our book: *Daniel's Prophecies Unsealed*. Excerpts of this material are included in Appendix 1 of this booklet.

The Seventy Weeks vision given to Daniel is a picture of God's ultimate plan to bring forgiveness to the entire world through a new covenant (see Jeremiah 31:31-37). From the time of the early church, Daniel's vision has always been applied to the Messiah fulfilling the six purposes given in Daniel 9:24. Many prominent scholars have applied the fulfillment of these six purposes to the Messiah (Barnes, Carroll, Hengstenberg, Hewitt, Mauro and Young to name a few).

The shocking discovery that Dr. Christian Widener has made is that God planned a SECOND fulfillment of this magnificent prophecy! The Roman armies swept into Jerusalem in 70 AD and desolated the city. Then in 1516-1517, the Ottomans' takeover of Jerusalem occurred to put in motion the means to fulfill a prophecy by Isaiah: "Foreigners will rebuild your walls, and their kings will serve you" (Isaiah 60:10).

Sultan Suleiman who was also known as "the Solomon of his age," was God's chosen vessel that restored and rebuilt the walls and portions of the Temple Mount by his orders. Dr. Christian Widener has well documented that Sultan Suleiman's decree took place between December 14th, 1536, and January 23rd, 1537. The decrees are actually placed on carved stone plaques documenting this historic time for the entire world to see!

If this remarkable finding is correct and God has planned a Second fulfillment of Daniel's Seventy Weeks, then we are living in the final days and, as Christian's title appropriately suggests, we are indeed *Witnessing The End*!

The purpose of this book is to distill this important message to help people understand where we are in God's prophetic time and to thereby inspire the reader to get ready to meet Jesus sometime this decade.

Preface

When Jesus came the first time, the religious leaders should have been able to determine the time. They had been instructed by the angel Gabriel to "know and understand" the timing in Daniel 9:25. Had they studied and applied Daniel's prophecy, they would have known that their Messiah was present! Because they failed to discern these things, they were admonished by the Lord.

Whenever you see a cloud rising out of the west, immediately you say, 'A shower is coming'; and so it is. And when you see the south wind blow, you say, 'There will be hot weather'; and there is. Hypocrites! You can discern the face of the sky and of the earth, but how is it you do not discern this time? (Luke 12:54-56)

Day and Hour

To ensure that we are not rebuked by Jesus, let's take a better look at what the Word of God has to say about knowing the timing. The most widely used verse people quote when they want to prove that we are not to know when Jesus is returning is found in Matthew:

But of that day and hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels of heaven, but my Father only (Matthew 24:36 – KJV).

What most people fail to remember; however, is the preceding verse: "Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away" (Matthew 24:35 – KJV). The day and hour that no one knew about when Jesus spoke those words were when heaven and earth will pass away at the end of the 1,000-year Millennium. The timing of when this will occur is found in Revelation 21:1: Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away.

The reason that this time is not known is found in Revelation 20:3, which says Satan is let out of the bottomless pit at the end of 1,000 years for: "a LITTLE SEASON." No one but God knows how long Satan will have to deceive the nations at that time.

Thief in The Night

The teaching that the wise and faithful will know and the unfaithful will not know was taught to us by Paul:

Now, brothers...about times and dates we do not need to write to you, for you know very well that the day of the Lord will come like a THIEF in the night. While people are saying, 'Peace and safety,' destruction will come on them suddenly, as labor pains on a pregnant woman, and they will not escape.

(1Thessalonians 5:1-3 - NIV).

Most people stop reading at the end of the third verse to try to prove their point that the Lord is going to come as a thief. He is coming like a thief, but to whom is He coming to as a thief? Notice what Paul says in the fourth verse: "But you, brothers, are not in darkness so that this day should surprise you like a THIEF."

Paul is saying that the Lord's coming should not surprise the Christian (**brother**). While the rest of the world will be surprised like a thief, the Christian should not be surprised.

This confirms what Jesus taught in His parables. The wise and faithful steward will be READY, WAITING and WATCHING for Him when He comes for them. The unfaithful and foolish servant will not be looking for Him and they will be taken by surprise.

The act of "watching" is serious business with our Lord. If we fail to continue diligently watching, Revelation 3:3 gives us fair warning:

Remember therefore how thou hast received and heard, and hold fast, and repent. If therefore thou shalt not watch, I will come on thee as a thief, and thou shalt not know what hour I will come upon thee (Revelation 3:3 – KJV).

Those who are not "watching" will be taken by surprise since a thief comes unannounced. The wise and faithful followers of Jesus; however, will be "watching" for Him and they will not be surprised.

The message in this book is that Jesus is returning very soon. If you have not been watching, begin "watching" today before it is too late! Jesus is coming very soon!

Introduction

⁵By faith Enoch was taken up so that he did not see death: "He could not be found, because God had taken him away." For before he was taken, he was commended as one who pleased God.

⁶And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who approaches Him must believe that He exists and that *He rewards those who earnestly seek Him*. (Hebrews 11:5-6 – BSB)

Enoch was Noah's great grandfather who is mentioned in the great hall of fame chapter on faith (Hebrews 11). Enoch was the first person to experience the rapture, which is described in Genesis: ²⁴Enoch walked with God, and then he was no more, because God had taken him away (Genesis 5:24 – BSB).

Because Enoch walked with God and he *pleased* Him by the life that he lived, God took him away before the time of the Flood arrived. While the Word of God does not indicate when this event occurred, there is a book entitled: *The Secrets of Enoch*, which records that Enoch was raptured on his birthday, the sixth of Sivan. The sixth of Sivan just happens to be the Feast of Pentecost (Day of Firstfruits). Enoch was born and also raptured on the Feast of Pentecost.

Very little is known about Enoch who was a righteous man who walked with God and pleased Him by the life that he lived. We also know that Enoch preached about the second coming of the Lord and about the coming judgment on those who are ungodly:

¹⁴Enoch, the seventh from Adam, also prophesied about them:
 "Behold, the Lord is coming with myriads of His holy ones
 ¹⁵to execute judgment on everyone, and to convict all the ungodly of every ungodly act of wickedness and every harsh word spoken against Him by ungodly sinners."
 (Jude 14-15 – BSB)

From Enoch's life (as a type-picture), we can surmise that participation in the coming rapture will be for those people of faith who are walking with God, living a life that will be found pleasing to Him.

Those taken in the rapture will also be actively watching for the soon return of the Lord and fervently telling others to get ready before it is too late as Enoch did.

This book c ontains a message that will not be acknowledged by everyone. Many in the Church will reject it because it goes against the many traditions so prevalent today, particularly about discussing a time for the Lord's return.

Nevertheless, the final piece of the puzzle in the book of Daniel has been found. It was literally hidden in plain sight until Dr. Christian Widener uncovered this treasured gem. His discovery will utterly astound you.

You are about to find out how God used a man named Sultan Suleiman to fulfill a prophecy given to the Prophet Daniel over 2,500 years ago. You will also learn how God utilized former President Donald Trump to help implement His plan for the final countdown in Daniel's prophecy.

More importantly, you will come to understand that our Lord Jesus Christ actually taught on the subject of the Rapture on two different occasions. Understanding His teachings will have a sobering effect on many.

Finally, once you are able to grasp the important truths expounded in this book, you will want to share this information with everyone you care about. You will be impelled to tell others that Jesus Christ is getting ready to return and of their need to be living a life that will be found pleasing in His sight just like Enoch.

Hang on to your hats because you are about to go on an exciting journey that will totally change your life!

Chapter 1

THE END IS NEAR

Is Jesus Christ Your Lord and Saviour?



As noted by Lyn Mize in the introduction to his book *The Open Door*, "there is one place in the Bible that states what a person must do in order to be saved. That verse states very simply the one and only one step for a person to be saved. The verse is as follows:

Acts 16:31 (KJV) And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.

This requirement for salvation could not be any simpler. There is not a step two to God's plan of salvation. There is only one step, and those well-meaning preachers, teachers and authors who add additional steps to God's plan are adding to the Bible. Some tracts give as many as twelve steps for salvation.

Jesus said, "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes in Me has eternal life" (John 6:47). The Bible has "been written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in His name" (John 20:31). You must believe that you are saved by simply believing in Jesus for eternal life (1 Timothy 1:16). We enter heaven through Jesus, who said, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me" (John 14:6). "I am the door; if anyone enters through Me, they will be saved" (John 10:9). We are saved "through Him" (Romans 5:9).

God the Father has designed a plan by which you can reach heaven. And His Son, Jesus has done all the work necessary in carrying out that plan. All you have to do is simply trust in Jesus alone for eternal life. The salvation that Jesus provides is completely by His marvelous Grace! (Ephesians 2:8-9).

The Final Countdown was written to alert the Church that Jesus Christ is about to return. If you have never believed on the Lord Jesus Christ for your personal salvation, then you should do so right now. As described above, believing on the Lord Jesus Christ is the only requirement for salvation.

Welcome back! We hope that you have made one of the most important decisions in your life by trusting your personal salvation to our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Now that you have been saved by the precious blood of the Lamb you should ask the Holy Spirit to help you as you read the Bible to learn all that God has for your life.

The next three chapters of this book will discuss how the Prophet Daniel was given an important prophecy that can be found in Daniel 9. This is one of the most debated chapters in the Bible and opinions vary widely as to the correct meaning.

Chapter 2 will show you what is known as the Messianic view of Daniel's Seventy Week, which was taught from the time of the early church. This view shows that Daniel's 70 weeks were completed at the time of Christ's first coming.

Chapter 3 will show the astonishing finding by Dr. Christian Widener that a man known as Suleiman the Magnificent was God's instrument to initiate another decree to rebuild the walls of Jerusalem in 1537.

Chapter 4 will show you how Suleiman's decree may be the Second Fulfillment of Daniel's 70 weeks. If Dr. Christian Widener's finding is correct, then Jesus will return before this decade is over.

Chapter 5 will show you where the Lord Jesus Christ taught His disciples He will come for His Church in two phases. This important chapter may have a direct impact on when you will get to see our Lord.

Chapter 2

TIMING OF CHRIST'S FIRST COMING

Seventy-Sevens After the First Decree



From the time of the early church, Daniel's 70 Week Prophecy has applied to Jesus Christ being the one to fulfill the prophecy. This was known as the Messianic view and was considered the accepted doctrine from the time of Jerome down through the centuries.

The following are some of the prominent expositors of God's Word who taught that the Seventy Weeks of Daniel applied to our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and not the Antichrist: Albert Barnes, B.H. Carroll, Ian M. Duguid, A.R. Fausset, Sinclair B. Ferguson, Curtis Hahn, Matthew Henry, E.W. Hengstenberg, Clarence H. Hewitt, Saint Jerome, Philip Mauro, Sir Isaac Newton, J.E.H. Thomson, John Urquhart, Ralph Woodrow and Edward J. Young.

Then in the late 1800's a new contemporary interpretation surfaced, which has captivated the masses with a new "tradition" that has become the modern church dogma of today. My original view of eschatology was firmly indoctrinated into believing this new tradition. Being a CPA, I was fascinated by the precision Sir Robert Anderson created in his book: *The Coming Prince*, which is considered the standard volume in the field and followed by most in today's church.

Anderson was a former Chief of Criminal Investigation in Scotland Yard who studied and wrote extensively, particularly on the subject of prophecy. His book gives very detailed and complex calculations which appear to give convincing "proof" that Daniel's prophecy predicted the exact day Christ was crucified. Because of this, Anderson's work has become the "gold standard" for people to go to on the book of Daniel.

The "traditional" teaching of today on the 70th Week of Daniel was developed from a change in the Authorized King James Bible back in 1885. The following is a brief excerpt from Appendix 3 of *Calling All Overcomers*: "This popular church tradition is a relatively new one. Dave Watchman wrote on this subject in an article entitled *The Truth of Daniel 9:27*. He notes that the error began in 1885 when the 'Revised Version' (R.V.) was recommended to be the <u>replacement</u> for the Authorized King James Bible by the so-called 'textual critics' of that Era. He then compares the purified Authorized Version (A.V.) with the corrupted Revised Version (R.V.) which renders Daniel 9:27 falsely. The R.V. "makes" the "he" the Antichrist, compared to the purified A.V. text which declares the "he" to be Jesus Christ:

Authorized King James Bible

And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, e ven until the consummation, a nd that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.

The Revised Version of 1885

And he shall make a firm covenant with many for one week: and for the half of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease: and upon the wing of abominations shall come one that maketh desolate; and even unto the consummation, and that determined, shall wrath be poured out upon the desolator.

"...the A.V. says 'and he (Jesus) shall confirm (strengthen) the covenant (referring to the Abrahamic covenant already mentioned in Daniel 9:4 and Genesis 12:1-3) with many for one week (7 years)', whereas the R.V. says 'And "he" (Antichrist) will make a firm covenant (peace) with many for one week (7 years)."

His article goes on to point out that Sir Robert Anderson and C.I. Scofield were close friends who used the false rendering brought out by the Revised Version in their classic works: *The Coming Prince* and the *Scofield Bible*. As time passed, other writers such as Larkin, Ironside, Pentecost, Walvoord, etc. wrote prophetic books that agreed with Sir Robert Anderson's faulty interpretation, which has formed the basis of today's popular teaching.

This changes the entire meaning of Daniel's magnificent vision and distorts the true significance of this important prophecy. Instead of being about the wonderful story of how God sent His Son to provide Israel an extended period of grace over a period of 490 years, the prophecy becomes a fabricated tale about the Antichrist coming to make a "7-year" peace treaty that is somehow *split off* from the first 483 years that were fulfilled at the time of Christ's first coming. This story has become the modern staple for the church today; blinding everyone from seeing the beautiful story Daniel was given.

Analysis of Anderson's The Coming Prince

The basis of most of today's eschatology was arrived at through the influence of Sir Robert Anderson and C.I. Scofield. Anderson's work was based upon three erroneous assumptions: an incorrect starting date, the use of a corrupted version of Scripture and the manipulation of dates through a faulty mode of reckoning.

Incorrect Starting Date

While Anderson begins his calculation of Daniel's seventy weeks with the correct decree of Artaxerxes' reign, the 20th year of the King did not occur in 445 BC, but in the year 454 BC as discovered by Dr. Floyd Jones (see p. 44 in *Daniel's Prophecies Unsealed*).

Corrupted Scripture

Instead of using the Authorized King James Bible of 1611, Anderson used the corrupted Revised Version of the Bible that came out in 1885. This incorrect rendering replaces Jesus Christ with the Antichrist, thereby changing the entire meaning of Daniel's prophecy. This flawed change has created today's teaching that has permeated most Bibles and books on prophecy. Anderson's work is now a cherished tradition that is dogmatically believed by almost everyone.

Faulty Reckoning

After beginning with an incorrect start date, Anderson used a 360-day lunar year to arrive at his conclusions. Instead of calculating Daniel's seventy weeks based upon our normal solar year of 365 days.

Anderson's work has recently come under attack due to his use of a 360-day prophetic year that Hengstenberg has noted was "a mode of reckoning, which was never adopted by the Hebrews, and therefore is so thoroughly destitute of foundation, that we need not stop to prove its incorrectness...(Hengstenberg, p. 211).


Today's "traditional" teaching has created a faulty scenario where the Church is "Raptured" away before the Antichrist comes to make a 7-year peace treaty with Israel. We find it extremely interesting that the word *Tradition* has a Gematria that totals: 666! In light of the findings in this book, which show the true meaning of Daniel's vision, readers are encouraged to seriously reconsider Anderson's work.


Timeline for Seventy Weeks

The timeline for the Seventy Weeks prophecy can be found on the following page. This timeline has been adjusted from the one shown in *Daniel's Prophecies Unsealed* to reflect Dr. Christian Widener's different starting date.

He used the start date of 457 B C (Decree in 7th Year of King Artaxerxes) and then moved forward 7 weeks (49 years) and then another 62 weeks (434 years) for a total of 483 years. This comes to 27 AD when Christ began His ministry. We believe His ministry was about 3 ½ years and in the middle of the final 70th week; Jesus was crucified (cut-off). After Christ's death, the Gospel message was preached almost exclusively to the Jewish people until the time recorded in Acts 10. There the Apostle Peter received a supernatural vision and he was sent to the house of Cornelius where he preached the Word of God and the Holy Spirit fell on the Gentiles for the first time; thereby ending the 490 years in approximately 33 AD.

The Seventy Weeks of Daniel were completely fulfilled during the time of Christ's first coming. The marvelous prophecy given to Daniel that is recorded in Daniel 9, was fully completed during Christ's first coming. Please see Appendix 1, which is an excerpt from *Daniel's Prophecies Unsealed*. There you will see all of the details of our original timeline and the changes we have incorporated to reflect portions of Dr. Christian Widener's great book.

Chapter 3

SULEIMAN THE MAGNIFICENT

God's Vessel to Rebuild Jerusalem



Once the nation of Israel had rejected their Messiah, and God turned His attention to the Gentiles, the seventy weeks (490 years) in Daniel's vision were completed. God then turned His attention to the Gentiles with the conversion of Cornelius.

Desolation of Jerusalem

The Jewish people had been given an extended period of grace of seventy weeks or 490 years. They crucified the Messiah and rejected the message the Apostles brought to save them. To make matters even worse, they continued to offer sacrifices in their Temple, which truly was an abomination in God the Father's eyes after they had rejected the sacrifice of His Son.

As noted by Hengstenberg, "The ancient temple is...changed, on account of the unbelief of the [Jewish] people and the murder of the Messiah, from a house of God into a house of abomination, which must be destroyed" (Hengstenberg, p. 169).

Because of this, God had the Roman armies sweep into Jerusalem to desolate the city and the Temple: "...and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate" (Daniel 9:27–KJ).

This shows that the flood of God's wrath against the Jews was because they continued to offer sacrifices in the Temple, which was the abomination that forced Him to send Titus to desolate the city. This desolation will continue until the consummation when the times of the Gentiles are completed.

The vision of the seventy weeks is a magnificent prophecy of God sending His Son to redeem all of mankind. E ven though Israel rejected their Messiah, God is not finished with them or with the Holy City of Jerusalem.

From 70 AD until the sixteenth century the Holy City was in a state of disrepair and ruins. Then in 1517, the Ottomans took control for the next four centuries. Ottoman sultan, Selim took possession of Jerusalem in March of that year, but when he died in 1520, he was survived by his only son, Suleiman. Suleiman was only 25 years old at the time and he found himself the ruler of an empire that stretched from the Balkans to the borders of Persia, from Egypt to the Black Sea.

"In Bagdad, I am the Shah, in Byzantine realms, the Caesar; and in Egypt, the Sultan,' he declared and to these titles he added that of caliph. No wonder the Ottoman courtiers addressed as...emperor, or as one of them wrote, 'the most honoured and respected sovereign the world over.' It is said that **Suleiman dreamed he was visited** by the Prophet who told him that 'to repulse the Infidels,' he must embellish the Sanctuary (Temple Mount) and rebuild Jerusalem,' His wife would repeatedly hail him, 'the Solomon of his age.' Suleiman inherited Jerusalem...and believed that his Islamic prestige demanded that he beautify the sanctuaries of Islam...His achievements in Jerusalem were so successful that the Old City today belongs more to him than anyone else." [Emphasis added.]

An overlooked prophecy given by Isaiah tells us:

Foreigners will rebuild your walls, and their kings will serve you (Isaiah 60:10).

Sultan Suleiman was given a dream that he was to rebuild the walls of Jerusalem and that he was to beautify the Temple Mount. Between 1537 and 1541, he undertook the mission that had been given to him in a prophetic dream by 'the Prophet.'

It appears that Suleiman the Magnificent was God's chosen vessel to fulfill Isaiah's prophecy of rebuilding God's Holy City of Jerusalem.

The city of Jerusalem that we see today is mostly the result of the achievements of Sultan Suleiman. As noted by Dr. Christian Widener:

The Decrees Carved in Stone!

"Sultan Suleiman restored many parts of Jerusalem between 1537-1541. His equivalent name in English is literally Solomon, and we know that he saw himself as a second King Solomon because he had the title engraved in stone during his reign...He placed carved stone plaques at many of the specific repairs that he made around the city to document them. But those stone plaques stand as a permanent record of his decrees regarding the restoration of Jerusalem...decrees that are etched in stone."

The Church is indebted to the remarkable findings made by Dr. Christian Widener. In the following chapter of this book, we will present several of his findings from these stone plaques that will give us clues to the timing of Christ's Second Coming.

Daniel's Vision – Pointing to Christ (Cut-off Middle of 70th Week) We need to remember that the prophecy that was given to Daniel was given to him by the angel Gabriel.

- 23) At the **beginning** of your supplications the command went out, and **I have come to tell you**, for you are **greatly beloved**; therefore consider the matter, and **understand the vision**:
 - 24) **Seventy weeks** are determined for your people and for your holy city, to finish the transgression, to make an end of sins, to make reconciliation for iniquity, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy, and to anoint the Most Holy (Dan 9:23-24).

The seventy weeks vision given to Daniel is a picture of God's ultimate plan to bring forgiveness to the entire world through a new covenant (see Jeremiah 31:31-34). In the previous chapter, we saw how the Seventy Weeks of Daniel were completely fulfilled during the time of Christ's first coming.

Daniel's holy vision given by the angel Gabriel pointed to Jesus Christ.

Suleiman's Dream – Points to Antichrist (Middle of 70th Week) Sultan Suleiman was given a dream by *the Prophet* instructing him to rebuild the walls of Jerusalem. This was to bring about the fulfillment of the prophecy in Isaiah 60:10, with foreigners rebuilding the walls.

God used Suleiman the Magnificent to fulfill His purpose of restoring His Holy City between the years 1537 to 1541. As we will see in the next chapter, Suleiman's dream will be tied to God bringing about the SECOND fulfillment of the Seventy Weeks of Daniel.

But this time it will be pointing to the Antichrist appearing in the middle of the 70th week, with Jesus fulfilling the entire Seventy Weeks at the Second Coming of Christ!

Dual Application To Scripture

The prophecies given in Daniel were given for a dual purpose:

Now I have come to make you understand what will happen to Your people in the latter days, for the vision refers to Many days yet to come (Daniel 10:14).

It is important to understand that the term the *latter days* has a dual meaning. When this was given to Daniel, it referred to the *first coming* of Jesus Christ to announce the kingdom to the Jewish people. But because God foreknew Jesus would be rejected by the Jews, the *latter days* also represents the time of Christ's *second coming*.

Similarly, the prophecy regarding the 70 W eeks also has a dual purpose. From the time of the early church, Daniel's 70 W eeks has applied to Jesus Christ fulfilling the prophecy (Messianic view). God also foreknew that there would be *another decree* to rebuild Jerusalem that He also ordained—pointing to the return of Jesus Christ at His *second coming* to rule and reign in the coming Kingdom.

The following chapter will outline how the decree *everyone missed* is being fulfilled right before our eyes. You will learn how Sultan Suleiman's decree began the Second fulfillment of Daniel's Seventy Weeks, which will be completed before this decade is over.

Chapter 4

TIMING OF CHRIST'S SECOND COMING

The Final Decree Everyone Missed



Because of the traditional interpretation that is believed and taught by the majority of Christians alive today, what you are about to discover will totally shock you. Most will immediately reject this new perspective and refuse to genuinely consider it. Changing one's paradigm is extremely difficult; particularly when it goes against everything we have been taught. As Author Bloomfield has said about tradition, "a person once infected is very difficult to reach. It seems as if one simply cannot get through to him."

Practically everyone who studies prophecy is looking for the Antichrist to arrive on the scene to make a 7-year peace treaty with Israel. Then after 3 ½ years, he is to break the treaty and begin his 42 months of persecution (Daniel 7:21, 25, 9:27).

Under this popular traditional teaching, the Rapture will take place before this 7-year treaty is signed and the entire Church will be taken away from the horrible tribulation period.

This author held this view until Marvin Rosenthal wrote his book: *The Pre-Wrath Rapture of the Church*. Attending the same church with Marvin motivated me to be a staunch Berean (Acts 17:11). As a result, the Lord showed me that he is partially correct. However, I also discovered that he missed the first phase of the rapture that Jesus also taught. This important aspect will be discussed in the next chapter.

Where Are We In God's Prophetic Timeline?

Most who are familiar with the subject of prophecy feel we must be close to the final days of the Church age. Numerous books have appeared lately setting various dates (2027 to 2033) for Christ's return.

Are any of these prognostications correct or are they merely vain attempts that will eventually prove to be false – leading scoffers to proclaim: "Where is the promise of His coming? For since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of creation" (2 Peter 3:3-4).

What you are about to read will completely change your perspective on where we are in God's prophetic timeline. Daniel's prophecy regarding the 70 W eeks includes a unique verse that specifically mentions the restoration of Jerusalem with *plaza* and *moat*:

So you are to know and discern that from the issuing of a decree to restore and rebuild Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince there will be seven weeks and sixty-two weeks; *it will be built again*, *with plaza and moat*, even in times of distress. (Daniel 9:25 – NASB)

New Discovery by Dr. Christian Widener

"In verse 25, it says that Jerusalem's restoration will include work at a "plaza and moat." If you read different translations, you will find that they have struggled with the proper meaning of the ancient Hebrew words in English. Some have translated it "streets" and "trench" for example....the word for plaza, *rechob*, was specifically used in Ezra 7:15-19, speaking about the plaza of the temple (i.e., the Temple Mount). It can also mean a wide street area (for a meeting place at a gate or square in the city), but we have a good scriptural tie for associating it with the temple, in this case."

"The word *charuwts* can mean a moat or trench, but a simple trench, such as a large ditch dug in the earth or rock, would not be listed as a structure that needed to be restored. It makes more sense that it was a large, fortified moat. Thus, plaza and moat look like the best translations of those words. Another reason we can be confident that the reference is to a moat is because one of the repairs Suleiman made included an actual moat. It can still be seen today around the Citadel of David, the so-called Tower of David (see photo, at the top of the next page), near the Jaffa Gate inside the Old City."

"The view is from the east side of the tower, looking north, and was taken January 13, 2020.

When the moat was repaired, he embedded a carved stone plaque in the wall to document his work. The part of the moat where the plaque is located was buried in 1898, but a photo of it was taken before it was covered over in the expansion of the city.

The photo below was taken by Max van Berehem before it was covered over in the expansion of the city."¹⁷²






"Here is the translation of the stone plaque above: 173 "The order to construct this tower for protection of the Islamic walls by his power and duration of his reign, and to dispose of the favouring idols by his force and strength, the One that did Allah especially elected to rule the neck of the Kings in the World, the possessor in chain of the throne of Caliphate, Sultan son of Sultan, son of Sultan, Son of Sultan..."

"It is truly amazing! There is an actual moat within the Old City of Jerusalem and it has a plaque proclaiming its restoration by Suleiman; however, there is no date on this specific plaque..."

"Fortunately, that is not the only plaque I want to show you. Suleiman also extensively repaired the plaza of the temple, and he placed a fountain (*sabil*) and another plaque with an inscription to document its restoration. It not only confirms that the Temple Mount was an area restored by Suleiman, but it also gives us a date for his decree. It is called *Sabil Bab el Atm*, meaning fountain at the Gate of Darkness (see photo, *below* ¹⁷⁴)."





"The translation of the plaque¹⁷⁵ is: "He has ordered the construction of this blessed Sabil, our Master, the Sultan, the greatest Sultan and the honourable Hakan, who rules the necks of the nations, the Sultan of the lands of Rum, the Arabs and Persians (ajams), the Sultan Suleyman, son of Sultan Selim Khan, may Allah perpetuate his reign and his sultanate, On the date of Hijra of the Prophet at the beginning of Shaban the blessed in the year 943. And blessings be upon Muhammed and upon his followers."¹⁷⁶

176 Tutuincuï. *Turkish Jerusalem*, 74; In total, Suleiman had nearly three dozen inscriptions documenting his work in Jerusalem between 1536-1541. Within the walls of the city, the oldest is at the *Sabil el Wad*, which is near the *Bab el Kattanin* (Cotton Merchants Gate) of the *Haram al-Sharif* (Temple Mount). It is dated December 14th, 1536. The next oldest one is at another fountain (*sabil*) in the city called, *Sabil Bab el Silsile*, dated January 4, 1537. These dates are all very close. I've highlighted the one that is located on the plaza of the temple (the Temple Mount), since "plaza" is mentioned in verse 25. Either way, we are looking at a decree date that is between December 14th, 1536, and January 23rd, 1537."

"The plaque Suleiman placed there is located at the north end of the Temple Mount about fifteen meters south of the Gate of Darkness (Bab el Atm), as shown in the diagram below. It is dated "the beginning of Shaban 943." The date given by this plaque converts to a modern date ranging from between the 13th to the 23rd of January. 1537 on our Gregorian calendar. 177 That gives us a verifiable date range from which to begin counting 483 years forward. ...if you count 483 years from 1537 that brings us to the year 2020!",3



Has The Final Countdown Begun?

Could it really be true? Has another 70th Week of Daniel actually begun without anyone realizing it? Have we entered into the final week and has the Final Countdown begun?

In the last chapter, we discovered how Sultan Suleiman was God's chosen vessel to fulfill the prophecy in Isaiah 60:10, that foreigners would rebuild the walls of Jerusalem. Now we see that Suleiman documented his work with over three dozen inscriptions etched in stone! And then we find that Suleiman placed his decree on the Temple Mount in the year 1537 (around January).

So you are to know and discern that from the issuing of a decree to restore and rebuild Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince there will be seven weeks and sixty-two weeks; it will be built again, with plaza and moat, even in times of distress (Daniel 9:25 – NASB).

If we multiply 69 weeks (7 weeks + 62 weeks) times 7, we get 483 years. And if we go forward 483 years from 1537, we arrive at 2020!

This means that Suleiman's decree in 1537, began the Second fulfillment of Daniel's Seventy-week prophecy. The final 70th Week of Daniel's prophecy began in 2020.

If this is true then there should be some evidence. Remember in the last chapter we came to realize there may be a dual rendering of Daniel's prophecy with the Antichrist confirming a peace treaty. Let's see what took place in 2020 regarding a possible covenant.

The Confirmation of the Covenant With Many

Dr. Christian Widener reminds us:

"First, we had an Israel-Palestine peace plan, sponsored by President Donald Trump and formally published on January 28th, 2020. 180 The plan was released almost exactly 483 years after these inscriptions. Then later the same year, some of the gulf Arab states began making peace with Israel under the Abraham Accords. 181

The first agreements were officially signed on the White House lawn on September 15, 2020. They were initially signed by UAE, Bahrain, Morocco, and Sudan, and other nations are also expected to adopt and sign these agreements. Hence, a new era of peace began in the region in 2020, as some key Arab states expressed their recognition of Israel and their interest in a broad-range collaboration to mutually benefit their countries.


Because Daniel's prophesied "confirmation of the covenant" will begin a final period of seven years, many expect there will be a formal peace treaty for a precise period of seven years. However, a seven-year time limit on the agreement is not explicit in the text. The Bible may say seven years because that is all the time that is left. Consequently, an agreement at the start of the tribulation would be de facto a seven-year agreement. Furthermore, by naming these peace deals with Israel as the "Abraham Accords," we are being shown that the "confirmation of the covenant" has been satisfied simply in the naming of the peace agreements" [Emphasis added].⁴

Incredibly, the world may have witnessed the beginning of the final seven years for the Second fulfillment of Daniel's Seventy Weeks without even knowing it! Trump's peace plan and the Abraham Accords with *the many* nations could be the prophetic implementation of God's final plan. (Please see Appendix 2, 3 and 4 for more details).

Chart – Second Fulfillment of The Seventy Weeks of Daniel

The chart that can be found on the next page summarizes what you have just read into a picture of where we may be in God's final timeline. This chart will probably upset you if you don't really want the Lord to come. If you are like me and you can't wait for Jesus to return, this will be exciting news that it may not be very much longer until we can get to be with our Lord.

The danger for all of us is to stubbornly defend what we have always believed because we are convinced it is true. But we could be wrong about some things so we always need to have a teachable spirit and open mind when it comes to the Word of God.



Chapter 5

THE TIMING OF THE RAPTURE

The Two Phases Jesus Taught



The timing of the rapture is one of the most controversial issues in the Church today. The traditional Pretribulation Rapture is the most popular view, but popularity should not be the measure of Scriptural truth. As alluded to in the previous chapter, this author held the Pretribulation view until Marvin Rosenthal introduced his Pre-Wrath Rapture position. We believe his view may be partially correct; however, we also think that he is incorrect in thinking that God will not remove any believers before the start of the *great tribulation*.

Phased Rapture Position

We have come to believe that the Bible teaches that the Rapture will take place in two distinct phases where the Lord will remove His Firstfruit believers at the beginning followed by the removal of the remaining believers in the Main Harvest before God pours out His wrath. It is important to point out that Jesus taught the doctrine of a "phased" Rapture of believers in both the earlier and later parts of His ministry. First, in the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus taught His disciples to pray for deliverance from the Tribulation period (Matthew 6:13). At the very end of His ministry when He gives His famous discourse on the Mount of Olives, He also instructs His followers to always pray for escape from the same Tribulation period (Luke 21:34-36).

34) And take heed to yourselves, lest at anytime your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, an drunkenness, and cares of this life, and so that day come upon you unawares. 35) For as a snare shall it come on all them that dwell on the face of the whole earth. 36) Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of Man (Luke 21:34-36 – KJV).

Jesus chose to teach His disciples this principle of a "phased" Rapture because there is a way to escape the *great tribulation*. The first time on the Mount of Beatitudes when He gave the famous "Lord's prayer," He tells us: "And do not lead us into temptation" but <u>deliver us</u> from the evil one (Matthew 6:13 – NIV). The Greek word for temptation is #3986 (peirasmos) which is the precise same term that Jesus uses in His promise to the Church of Philadelphia:

Since you have kept my command ("word" – KJ) to endure patiently, *I* will also keep you from the hour of tiral 3986 that is going to come upon the whole world to test those who live on the earth (Revelation 3:10 - NIV).

In other words, in the Lord's prayer, Jesus is telling us that we should be praying for God to deliver us from the coming trial of the Antichrist (evil one). This is the promise given to the Church of Philadelphia and it is also the same prayer mentioned above in His instructions on the Mount of Olives (*pray always to be accounted worthy to escape*).


Please notice that both times were on a "Mount," both times He taught this privately to His disciples, and both times He included important instructions in a prayer for His disciples to follow. Jesus would not have taught us to pray to escape the coming Tribulation if it were not possible to do so. So while escape is possible, please notice that it is also very conditional. We need to be accounted worthy to escape (Luke 21:36) and we need to be found keeping His word (Revelation 3:10) to escape the coming tribulation period.


The faithful Philadelphian believer has the ears to hear and the heart to understand this teaching while most of the Church prefers to follow the Traditions of man (Colossians 2:8). The faithful, overcomer heeds the Lord's advice and continually *prays for deliverance* from the coming Tribulation period.

This teaching is not a new idea but was taught by many great men of God in the Philadelphia church age. Men like J.Hudson Taylor, Dr. A.B. Simpson, John Wilkison, Joseph A. Seiss, and Ray Brubaker. 
Now that we see that there is a way to escape the coming tribulation period, we need to see how this fits in with the fact that the tribulation will not be for the traditional period of 7 years as we have been taught.

We believe that the *great tribulation* is only 3 ½ years long and the traditional Pre-Trib, Mid-Trib, and Post-Trib Rapture positions can now be modified using the Phase Rapture approach with the faithful Firstfruit believers (accounted worthy) taken at the beginning followed by the rapture of the Main Harvest believers (lukewarm) at the end.





We need to remember that if Sultan Suleiman's decree in 1537, began the Second fulfillment of Daniel's Seventy-week prophecy then the final 70th Week began in 2020. This means that the Antichrist is due to appear very soon. Depending upon when in 2020 the final 7 years began, the mid-point could be anywhere between 2023 and 2024. The purpose of this book is not to set an exact date, but to alert the reader to the fact that time is very short and everyone needs to be preparing their hearts to meet Jesus today, while there is still time.



Parable of the Ten Virgins

The Great God of Heaven has announced in His Holy Word that a grand wedding is about to take place. Mankind's time on this earth is about up, and the Bridegroom is getting ready to return for His bride. Are you part of the bride of Christ? Will you be ready when Jesus returns? Who is it that is invited to the wedding banquet? It is those described in Revelation 19:7 and 9:

...For the wedding of the Lamb has come, and his bride has made herself ready...Then the angel said to me, "Write: Blessed are those who are invited to the wedding supper of the Lamb!" And he added "These are the true words of God (Revelation 19:7,9 – NIV).

Notice that the above verse says, "The bride made herself ready..." How did she make herself ready?

And to her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the *fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints* (Revelation 19:8 – NKJV).

The bride made herself ready for the wedding by obtaining her fine linen. This was her reward for the righteous life that she lived. The original Greek confirms that this fine linen is not the righteousness that is imputed to every believer in Christ but represents the righteous acts or the righteous living of the believer (conduct, acts, and deeds) following their salvation. This same teaching was confirmed for us by Jesus when He taught about the ten virgins:

1) Then the kingdom of heaven shall be likened to ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom. 2) Now five of them were wise, and five of them were foolish. Those who were foolish took their lamps and took no oil with them, 4) but the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps. 5) But while the bridegroom was delayed, they all slumbered and slept. 6) And at midnight a cry was heard: 'Behold, the bridegroom is coming; go out to meet him!' 7) Then all those virgins arose and trimmed their lamps. 8) And the foolish said to the wise, 'Give us some of your oil, for our lamps, are going out.' 9) But the wise answered, saying, 'No, lest there should not be enough for us and you; but go rather to those who sell, and buy for yourselves.' 10) And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came, and those who were ready went in with him to the wedding; and the door was shut (Matthew 25:1-10 – NKJV).

Here we see that only the five wise virgins who were ready went to be with their Bridegroom. All 10 virgins were Christians because all did possess their oil, which represents the Holy Spirit who was given to each of them upon their conversion. The 5 foolish virgins, however, did not carry along the extra measure of oil that the 5 wise virgins carried in their jars. The 5 wise virgins were ready because they were obedient to the Word of God, which commands us to be "filled with the Spirit" (Ephesians 5:18). Because the 5 wise virgins were filled with the Spirit, they allowed Him to direct and empower their life.

It is important to note that the extra oil had to be bought by the foolish virgins (v.9). While the indwelling spirit is a free gift from God that cannot be bought, being filled by the Holy Spirit involves effort on the part of the Christian, requiring our submission to Him (Galatians 5:16-25) in order to crucify the flesh and allow Him complete control. As a result, the 5 wise virgins were properly equipped when the Bridegroom arrived. The wise virgins were ready because of their faithfulness, while the foolish virgins were not prepared due to their own lethargy in providing their extra measure of oil to keep their lamps burning.

Are you a wise or foolish virgin today? If you are not sure, please consider making the following prayer right now:

"Dear God in Heaven, I realize that I have not really been living my life for you. I humbly turn to you right now and ask you to forgive me. Dear Jesus, please rule and reign in my heart and life. Please help me to live for you for whatever time remains. I pray that I may be accounted worthy and that I may be able to stand before you when you return. In Jesus' name, I pray. Amen"

Our prayer is that many who read this book will pray this prayer and ask the Lord to help them be prepared for His return. We know for certain Jesus will return very soon and we need to be ready every single day as we eagerly await His coming for us.

Epilogue



If we are witnessing the final days before the rapture we must alert all of our friends and loved ones before it is too late. We cannot allow the fear of what others think of us to keep us from helping to get people prepared.

If you think things have been bad since 2020, you have no idea what is in store after the Antichrist appears on the scene. 
If Sultan Suleiman's decree in 1537 began the Second Fulfillment of Daniel's Seventy-week prophecy then the final 7-years began in 2020. We know that Enoch's life served as a type-picture of the Firstfruit believer and since his rapture took place on the Feast of Pentecost (Enoch's birthday) it is a highly likely time for the Firstfruit rapture.⁵

While we can not be certain that the Feast of Pentecost is the correct time for the rapture, the wise and faithful believers will take Matthew Henry's advice: "Therefore every day and every hour we must be ready, and not off our watch any day in the year, or any hour in the day." (Matthew Henry, Volume 5, p. 372)⁶

Eye has not seen, nor ear heard nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared *for those who love Him*.

(1 Corinthians 2:9)

Do you love Him? Jesus said, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My Word." (John 14:23)

Appendix 1 – Daniel's 70 Weeks



Please read Daniel 9, prior to reading this appendix:

Verses
1 to 19
20 to 27
24 to 27

The date for this chapter was around 537 B C and Daniel was studying the Scriptures relating to the seventy years of exile for his people and the desolation of the city of Jerusalem. A ccording to Jeremiah 25:11; 29:4-10, he realized that their time of captivity was almost over (606 BC less 70 years = 536 BC). Daniel was a devout man of God who greatly mourned for what had befallen his people because of their rebellion against God. He earnestly poured out his heart asking for forgiveness and restoration.

And I prayed to the LORD my God, and made confession, and said, "O Lord, great and awesome God, who keeps His covenant and mercy with those who love Him, and with those who keep His commandments..." (Daniel 9:4)

He realized they had been taken into Babylon because they had not really loved God nor kept His commandments. They had not repented of their evil ways after the Lord had sent prophets admonishing them. Their seventy years were about to expire, and Daniel was seeking the Lord for himself and his people.

He was told by the angel Gabriel "thou art greatly beloved" (Daniel 9:23). God greatly loved Daniel and He sent his holy messenger to answer his prayer the very moment he began to make his pleas.

23) At the **beginning** of your supplications the command went out, and **I** have come to tell you, for you are greatly beloved; therefore consider the matter, and understand the vision:

24) **Seventy weeks** are determined for your people and for your holy city, to finish the transgression, to make an end of sins, to make reconciliation for iniquity, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy, and to anoint the Most Holy (Daniel 9:23-24).

In answer to Daniel's prayer, the Lord revealed His plans: not only would He restore His people and His Holy city, but He also gave him a vision that would span over the next seventy weeks of years or 490 years. In other words, the Jews were driven into captivity for seventy years because of their sins, but now God was going to restore them over a period of 490 years (seventy weeks of years). This extended period of grace is a reflection of the unlimited forgiveness Jesus would bring. God's mercy was alluded to when Peter asked Jesus if he should forgive a brother seven times. Jesus said to him, "I do not say to you, up to seven times, but up to seventy times seven" (Mat 18:22).

The seventy weeks vision given to Daniel is a picture of God's ultimate plan to bring forgiveness to the entire world through a new covenant (see Jeremiah 31:31-34). From the time of the early church, this vision has always been applied to the Messiah, fulfilling the six purposes given (Hewitt, p. 253).

Doing Away With Sin¹

finish the transgression – Israel's sins / Forgiveness of all sins make an end of sins – Hebrews 10:1-18 make reconciliation for iniquity – Hebrews 9:26-28 One sacrifice

Bringing the Good News²

bring in everlasting righteousness - 2 Corinthians 5:21 seal up vision and prophecy - Luke 16:16 anoint the Most Holy - Anointing church at Pentecost (Acts 2)

The six distinct things listed were all fulfilled by the coming of the Messiah, who was God's final atonement for mankind. All of these purposes were accomplished during these seventy weeks of years. Gabriel then explains how this extended period of grace will be accomplished.

The vision is broken down into the following segments: v. 25 v. 26 v.27 7 weeks + 62 weeks + 1 week $(\frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{2})$ = 70 weeks

25) Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the command to <u>restore and build Jerusalem</u> until Messiah the Prince, there shall be seven weeks and sixty-two weeks; the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublesome times (Daniel 9:25).

In order to understand the entire vision, we first need to determine the correct starting point. Based upon the above verse, we must find where the command to restore and build Jerusalem took place. The following Scriptures should be considered:

Ezra 1:1-3

1st Year of Cyrus Proclamation to Build Temple

Ezra 7:8, 11-26

7th Year of Artaxerxes Authorize Ezra to Restore Temple

Ezra 4:24; 6:7,8

2nd Year of Darius Reaffirmation to Rebuild Temple

Nehemiah 2:1-9

20th Year of Artaxerxes Authorize to Finish Rebuilding Jerusalem

There is very little unanimity among expositors over which of the above four decrees is the correct starting point for Daniel's vision.³ This is easily resolved when we see Nehemiah's prayer for the restoration of the city (Nehemiah 1). God quickly answered his prayer, and King Artaxerxes gave him authorization to rebuild it almost immediately. Daniel's divine vision refers to restoring and rebuilding the city, including the streets and walls during times of trouble. Notice how Nehemiah describes the situation:

Come and let us build the wall of Jerusalem, that we may no longer be a reproach...""...half of my servants worked at construction, while the other half held the spears, the shields, the bows, and wore armor; and the leaders were behind all the house of Judah (Neh 2:17; 4:16).

Nehemiah's account of his mission plainly shows the *troublesome times* that the angel Gabriel must have referred to. We believe that it clearly aligns with the requirements given in Daniel's vision of the seventy weeks, which places the correct starting point of this key prophecy at the 20th year of King Artaxerxes' reign. As noted by one eminent commentator: "This is the first and only royal decree granting permission to "restore and build Jerusalem" (Walvoord, p. 276).

20th Year of Artaxerxes

The next major difficulty in ascertaining the point to begin our timeline is determining when the 20th year of Artaxerxes actually occurred. The most popular date given by most scholars is around 445 or 444 BC. This is the time used by Sir Robert Anderson in his famous work *The Coming Prince*, in which he calculated the date Christ was crucified. His book has recently come under attack due to his use of a 360-day prophetic year that one commentator noted was "a mode of reckoning, which was never adopted by the Hebrews, and therefore is so thoroughly destitute of foundation, that we need not stop to prove its incorrectness…" (Hengstenberg, p. 211).

Moreover, new evidence has recently been established that dates the 20th year of Artaxerxes as 454 BC.⁴ Dr. Floyd Nolen Jones' significant work *The Chronology of the Old Testament* was first published in 1993. Dr. Jones's painstaking volume gives us a fresh new solution to Daniel's prophecy based upon a modification to the previous work of Ussher's monumental work *The Annals of the World*, published in 1658. With the biblically corrected date of 454 BC as the 20th year of King Artaxerxes, we have determined the proper starting point for Daniel's seventy weeks.

Interestingly, after we uncovered this correct beginning date, we found two older expositors who had previously determined Daniel's seventy weeks should also begin around 454 BC. Albert Barnes (1834)⁵ arrived at 454 BC, while E. W. Hengstenberg (1864)⁶ calculated 455 BC. These eminent scholars realized this important time well before recent expositors appeared creating unfounded interpretations based upon the erroneous date of 444–445 BC. Many of the traditions taught today were based upon this inaccurate chronology.

Timeline for Seventy Weeks

The timeline for the seventy weeks of years can be found at the end of this appendix on page 58. From the start date of 454 BC the prophecy states we should move forward 7 weeks (49 years) and then another 62 weeks (434 years) for a total of 483 years. The remaining 1 week (7 years) follows the 483 years for a total of 490 years (7 x 70 weeks).

If we move forward from 454 BC by 49 years, we come to around 405 BC. While there are no known records in the Scripture that point to this exact moment in time, Albert Barnes noted: "the completion of the work undertaken by Nehemiah ...reached to the period here designated; and his last act as governor of Judea, in restoring the people and placing the affairs of the nation on its former basis, occurred at just about the period of the forty-nine years after the issuing of the command by Artaxerxes. That event, as is supposed above, occurred in 454 BC. The close of the seven weeks, or the forty-nine years, would therefore be 405 BC. This would be about the last year of the reign of Darius Nothus."

...from the going forth of the command to restore and build Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince, there shall be <u>seven weeks</u> and <u>sixty-two</u> <u>weeks</u> (Daniel 9:25).

The sixty-two weeks (434 years) takes us to 29-30 AD. (454 BC + 49 years + 434 years = 29-30 AD).

Christ's Ministry

The year 29-30 AD is the time when Jesus began His ministry as recorded in the four Gospels. He was baptized in the Jordan River and He preached about the coming Kingdom for a total of approximately $3\frac{1}{2}$ years, after which He was crucified.

And after the sixty-two weeks Messiah shall be cut off, but not for Himself... (Daniel 9:26)

Jesus was killed or *cut off* because the Jews rejected their Messiah and the Romans crucified Him on a cross, precisely as the Prophet Daniel saw in the vision the angel Gabriel had explained over twenty-five hundred years ago.

And he shall confirm (strengthen)¹³⁹⁶ the covenant with many for one week; and in the midst of the week He shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease... (Daniel 9:27 – KJ)

Jesus began his ministry that was stopped halfway through (i.e., middle of seven years = $3\frac{1}{2}$ years). Jesus had come to **strengthen** the covenant of love and mercy as mentioned previously in His prayer: "O Lord, great and awesome God, who keeps His covenant and mercy..." (Daniel 9:4)

The covenant that Daniel is referring to is the covenant of love and mercy that God made with his people. Notice what Jesus had to say regarding this covenant at the Last Supper:

And he said unto them, this is my blood of the **new covenant** which is **shed for many** (Mark 14:24).

At the Last Supper, the Lord was revealing how the wine the disciples were about to drink represented the blood of a *new covenant*, which was about to be shed the very next day. His blood actually strengthens the original covenant because there would no longer be any need to continue to offer sacrifices to God (i.e., *He shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease*). His act of love by dying on the cross ended sacrifices and made the original covenant a m ore durable covenant that would permanently bind His love to all of humanity.

The precious lifeblood of Jesus Christ is like superglue that forever binds God's covenant of love and mercy to mankind. His atonement creates an everlasting bond of God's love that can never be broken (*cf.* Hebrews 7:22-28; Hebrews 9:11-15).

Calling Cornelius After 3½ Years

Jesus was crucified in the middle of the seventieth week of Daniel (in the midst of the week) after which the Good News of the coming kingdom was preached to the people of Israel. R emember, the extended period of grace promised in Daniel's vision was for seventy weeks of years, i.e., 490 years. A fter Christ's death there still remained three and one-half years in order to fulfill God's purposes to

Jewish people. O ver this period the Gospel was preached almost exclusively to the Jews.

The confirmation of the new covenant to the people of Israel continued from the day of Pentecost when 3,000 Jews were saved, and as noted by another eminent commentator: "In that three and one-half years it is stated more than once that great numbers of Jews...were converted...one might safely conclude 100,000 Jews were converted and brought to the knowledge of the truth..." (Carroll, p. 133).

But Israel's extended day of grace came to an end when the Jews persecuted the Church and Stephen was stoned (Acts 7:54-60). Shortly thereafter, G od's program turned from the Jewish people when the Apostle Peter received a supernatural vision. He was sent to the house of Cornelius, where he preached the Word of God and the Holy Spirit fell on the Gentiles for the first time. P eter then commanded them to be baptized in the name of the Lord (please see Acts 10)⁹.

Jesus alluded to this same time of $3\frac{1}{2}$ years in His parable of the barren fig tree: "...Look, for three years I have come seeking fruit on this fig tree and find none...But he said...let it alone this year also...and if it bears fruit well. But if not, after that you can cut it down" (Luke 13:7-8).

Destruction of Jerusalem

Once the people of Israel failed to bear fruit, the final week ended. The seventy weeks (490 years) in Daniel's vision were completed, and God turned his attention to the Gentiles with the conversion of Cornelius. Since Israel rejected Christ and the Apostles' message, Jesus says the *fig tree* should be cut down.

Notice that the destruction of Jerusalem and the Temple occurs after the seventy weeks are completed. The prince who was to come was Titus who led the Roman armies. Jesus also alluded to this time: "But when you see Jerusalem surrounded by armies, then know that its desolation is near" (Luke 21:20).

...and the people of the <u>prince who is to come shall destroy the city</u> and the sanctuary. The end of it shall be with a flood, and till the end of the war <u>desolations are determined</u> (Daniel 9:26).

Abomination of Desolation

The Jewish people had been given an extended period of grace of seventy weeks or 490 years. They crucified the Messiah and rejected the message the Apostles brought to save them. To make matters even worse, they <u>continued to offer sacrifices</u> in their Temple, which truly <u>was an abomination</u> in God the Father's eyes after they had rejected the sacrifice of His Son.

As noted by Hengstenberg, "The ancient temple is...changed, on account of the unbelief of the [Jewish] people and the murder of the Messiah, from a <u>house of God</u> into a <u>house of abomination</u>, which must be destroyed" (Hengstenberg, p. 169).

Because of this, God had the Roman armies sweep into Jerusalem to desolate the city and the Temple: "...and for the <u>overspreading of abominations</u> he shall <u>make it desolate</u>, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate" (Daniel 9:27–KJ).

This shows that the flood of God's wrath against the Jews was because they continued to offer sacrifices in the Temple, which was the abomination that forced Him to send Titus to desolate the city. This desolation will continue until the consummation when the times of the Gentiles are completed.¹⁰

The vision of the seventy weeks is a magnificent prophecy of God sending His Son to redeem all of mankind. E ven though Israel rejected their Messiah, God is not finished with them.



"A remnant of them will return; the <u>destruction decreed</u> shall <u>overflow with righteousness</u>. For the Lord God of hosts will make a determined end in the midst of the land" (Isaiah 10:22-23).

"...that blindness in part has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in.

And so all Israel will be saved..." (Romans 11:25-26).

In 1948, we witnessed the beginning of the return of the remnant. The story is not quite over, but the time of the end is rapidly approaching.




The chart on the following page is the one that was included in our book: *Daniel's Prophecies Unsealed*, which was published in 2018. It is based upon using the decree found in Nehemiah 2:1-9 as outlined above.


The chart that can be found on the facing page has been adjusted to use the decree that Dr. Christian Widener utilized in his book: *Witnessing The End* (based upon Ezra 7:8, 11-26). We have adjusted the chart he has on page 150, in his book to show a slightly different interpretation of the final 70th week. Instead of using his 7-year period for Christ's ministry, we show this 7-year period as divided into two parts: (1) the traditional 3 ½ years of ministry followed by (2) the 3 ½ year period following the crucifixion. During this time the Gospel was preached almost exclusively to the Jews until the Apostle Peter was sent to the house of Cornelius. There he preached the Word of God and the Holy Spirit fell on the Gentiles for the first time.

Summary

In *Daniel's Prophecies Unsealed* we used 3 BC for the birth of Christ and a ministry start date of 29/30 AD with the Seventy Weeks ending in 36/37 AD. Dr. Christian Widener makes a good case for a start date of 27 AD, which appears to line up with his computation for the Jubilee years. Under this scenario, the Seventy Weeks would end in 33/34 AD.

While we cannot be dogmatic as to which model is correct, we believe either one shows that the Seventy Weeks (490 Years) were fulfilled at Christ's first coming.

Appendix 2 – The Abominations of Desolations



There are several cases where the Abominations of Desolations are mentioned in the book of Daniel, which has led to misinterpretation when not understood within the correct context. Here are four occurrences found in the book of Daniel:

False Prophet	Daniel 8:11-14
Destruction of Jerusalem	Daniel 9:27
Antiochus Epiphanes	Daniel 11:31
Antichrist	Daniel 12:11

In addition to the book of Daniel, the term is also found in the New Testament in several places. Jesus used the term in Luke 21:20, in predicting the destruction of Jerusalem when Titus surrounded Jerusalem in 70 AD, and it could also have its *second fulfillment* at the future battle of Armageddon when all of the nations come against Israel:

And they gathered them together to the place in Hebrew, Armageddon (Revelation 16:16).

16 And He has a name written on His robe and on His thigh: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.

17 Then I saw an angel standing in the sun, and he cried out in a loud voice to all the birds flying overhead, "Come, gather together for the great supper of God, 18 so that you may eat the flesh of kings and commanders and mighty men, of horses and riders, of everyone slave and free, small and great." 19 Then I saw the beast and the kings of the earth with their armies assembled to wage war against the One seated on the horse, and against His army. 20 But the beast was captured along with the false prophet, who on its behalf had performed signs deceiving those who had the mark of the beast and worshiped its image. Both the beast and the false prophet were thrown alive into the fiery lake of burning sulfur. 21 And the rest were killed with the sword that proceeded from the mouth of the one seated on the horse. (Revelation 19:16-21 – BSB)

Abominations of Desolations

Several cases of "abomination of desolation" are mentioned in Daniel.

Occurrence	<u>Daniel</u>
False Prophet	8:11-14
Destruction of Jerusalem	9:27
Antiochus Epiphanes	11:31
Antichrist	12:11

False Prophet (End of Great Tribulation)

11) Yea, he magnified himself even to the prince of the host, and by him the daily [sacrifice] was taken away, and the place of his sanctuary was cast down. 12) And an host was given him against the daily [sacrifice] by reason of transgression, and it cast down the truth to the ground; and it practiced, and prospered. 13) Then I heard a holy one speaking,.... 'For how long is the vision concerning... the transgression that makes desolate, and the giving over of the sanctuary and host to be trampled underfoot?' 14) And he said to me, for 2,300 evenings and mornings [1,150 days]¹ Then the sanctuary shall be restored to its rightful state" (Daniel 8:13-14- ESV). In chapter 3 of Daniel's Prophecies Unsealed we learned that the little horn of Daniel 8 represents the false prophet who will cast down truth to the ground (deceive many) at the time of the end (p. 38-40). The false prophet will persecute the saints (host to be trampled underfoot), causing the transgression that makes desolate, after which time they will be restored in the New Jerusalem (Revelation 21:2, 9-10). This period of 1,150 days will end toward the very end of the tribulation period.

Destruction of Jerusalem (70 AD)

As we learned in Appendix 1, the <u>abomination of desolation</u> in Daniel 9:27 was the fact that the Jewish people <u>continued to offer sacrifices</u> in the Temple even after Jesus had made the ultimate sacrifice of dying for all of humanity. B ecause of this, the city of Jerusalem was destroyed by Titus in 70 AD just as Jesus had predicted: "But when you see Jerusalem surrounded by armies, then know that its desolation is near" (Luke 21:20) [+ 2nd fulfillment at end of Tribulation].²

Antiochus Epiphanes (165 BC)

The <u>abomination of desolation</u> in Daniel 11:31 was created by Antiochus Epiphanes when he set up a statue of Jupiter in the Temple and sacrificed a hog on the altar. This abomination took place in 165 BC and was not the desolations Jesus referred to in Matthew 24 or Luke 21.

Antichrist (Beginning of Great Tribulation)

Jesus made another prediction about a future <u>abomination of</u> <u>desolation</u>, which He said Daniel referred to:

15) Therefore when you see the <u>abomination of desolation</u>, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, <u>standing in the holy place</u> (whoever reads, let him understand)...21) For then there will be <u>great tribulation</u>, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be.

(Matthew 24:15, 21)

And from the time that the daily [sacrifice] is taken away, and the <u>abomination of desolation</u> is set up, there shall be one thousand two hundred and ninety days [1,290 days] (Daniel 12:11).

The abomination that Jesus referred to in Matthew concerns the time of great tribulation during the final 3½ years before the second coming. The Apostle Paul described the leader (Antichrist) during this period as follows:

(3) that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition; (4) Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, shewing himself that he is God (2 Thessalonians 2:3-4).

The Antichrist will cause another <u>abomination of desolation</u> when he arrives in Jerusalem claiming to be God at the start of the great tribulation.

How Long is a Generation?

Now learn a parable of the fig tree; When his branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer is nigh: So likewise ye, when ye shall see all these things, know that it is near, even at the doors. Verily I say unto you, This generation shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled. (Matthew 24:32-34 – KJV)

What was the average life expectancy at the time of Jesus?

Those living in the days of **Jesus** (as mentioned in the New Testament) had an **average life span** that was similar to human life spans before the arrival of modern medicine and technology. At the time Jesus spoke the above words, the **average life expectancy** was around 30 to 35 years, similar to the **life span** of those in classical Rome.

32 AD + 35 = 67 AD around the time that the Romans' siege of Jerusalem began ($3\frac{1}{2}$ years of judgment), ending in 70 AD.

In 1948 the average life expectancy was approximately 70 years (or 80 because of strength, as in Psalm 90).

$$1948 + 70 = 2018 + ?$$

The days of our life are **seventy years**— Or even, if because of strength, **eighty years**; Yet their pride [in additional years] is only labor and sorrow, For it is soon gone and we fly away. (Psalm 90:10 – AMP)

Appendix 3 – The Temple Mount



One big question people have regarding the timing of end-time events is how can the Antichrist proclaim himself to be God in the temple when the temple has not been built? A related question is how he can confirm a peace treaty that has already been signed. The purpose of this appendix is to address these types of questions and provide some plausible explanations.

Remember in chapter 3, we discussed the dual application to Scripture and how Daniel's 70 W eeks applied to Jesus fulfilling the first application with His First Coming and how the second application will be tied to the Antichrist in Christ's Second Coming.

He will confirm a covenant with many for one 'seven.' In the middle of the 'seven' he will put an end to sacrifice and offering. And *at the temple* he will set up an abomination that causes desolation, until the end that is decreed is poured out on him.

(Daniel 9:27 – NIV)

First, let's look at the first part of this verse. Notice that the Antichrist only confirms the covenant with many other nations. It does not say that he drew up the treaty, but he merely confirms it. Dr. Christian Widener's observations are quite perceptive:

"The mention of confirming the covenant does not necessarily mean that the Antichrist is the one who drafts the treaty or declaration. He just must somehow lend his support to it. The statement, "with the many" is likely an allusion to the many nations that will likewise support it in a collective peace deal or agreement. In the process, they will acknowledge Israel's right to exist as a nation—and that their right to the land comes from God, through the Abrahamic Covenant. Also, the Antichrist will just be one of the participants in the whole affair.

And it may not be obvious that he soon will be the Beast that begins to rule the nations of the earth three and a half years later in the great tribulation. Furthermore, since there will only be seven years left for human government until the return of Christ, this means that any "confirmation of the covenant" will be de facto for seven years, so the treaty doesn't have to specify seven years in its terms." (Widener, p.303)

Remember that President Trump sponsored the "Peace to Prosperity" plan in January 2020, which was almost exactly 483 years from the time Sultan Suleiman issued his decree to rebuild areas on the Temple Mount in 1537. This 181-page document can be downloaded on our website under the Supplemental Articles for our book: Daniel's Prophecies Unsealed www.ProphecyCountdown.com

"Then later that same year, the Abraham Accords emerged and presented a viable candidate for the fulfillment of Daniel's **prophecy**. Many wondered whether the accords would survive the transition to a new democratic administration in the U.S. under President Biden; however, when the Abraham Accords passed their one-year anniversary, not only were they still in place, but they were also bearing fruit! The accords were then embraced by the Biden administration and have continued to flourish. Indeed, it was soon evident that they were not just another peace deal fiasco. but instead were potentially something prophetically significant. Then came the Abraham Accords, 298 which included official recognition of the State of Israel by the Arab countries who signed it, and it began opening a new era of peace in the region.²⁹⁹ Securing peace with Israel's neighbors is a big step toward securing peace with the Palestinians since their cause has usually been universally supported by the Muslim nations. The more they lose that support, though, the more pressure they have to actually negotiate a resolution to the conflict." (Widener, pp 304-5) [Emphasis added]

Readers can read and download all of these historic peace agreements that are located beneath the "Peace to Prosperity" plan mentioned above.

It appears that President Donald Trump may have initiated the final peace initiative alluded to by the Prophet Daniel right before our eyes. The covenants were signed by the leaders in Israel along with the nations from the Kingdom of Bahrain, the Kingdom of Morocco, the Republic of Sudan, and the United Arab Emirates.

It may be noteworthy that several of these Abrahamic Accords were also signed by former Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu. As of this writing, the current government in Israel is being dissolved with new elections being called later this year. This could set the stage for a return to power by longtime Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, who has said that he wants to form a wide national government. Could some of the leaders who helped initiate these Accords be in place when the Antichrist appears? Regardless, if they are, when the Antichrist does appear he could *confirm the covenant with many* (Daniel 9:27) simply by signing onto the Accords that have already been put in place and previously signed by the *many* nations.

Remember, the covenant does not need to be a 7-year agreement. It is a 7-year covenant by virtue of the fact that it only has a period of 7 years before the 70^{th} Week is completed. I think that we have all been guilty of reading something into the prophecy that is not there.

Reinstating Sacrifices on the Temple Mount

In the middle of the 'seven' he will put an end to sacrifice and offering. And at the temple he will set up an abomination that causes desolation, until the end that is decreed is poured out on him.

(Daniel 9:27 – NIV)

We will now address the issue of how the Antichrist will put an end to the sacrifices that haven't even started yet. It says that he will bring them to an end 'in the middle" of the seven-year period. If the final 70th Week of Daniel began sometime in 2020, then we are approaching the halfway mark someplace between the middle of 2023 or the middle of 2024.

This would mean that animal sacrifices would need to begin sometime next year (2023) or the following year (2024) at the latest.

"Then after the Abraham Accords were inaugurated in 2020, people started asking the question of whether it was time to normalize the Temple Mount, meaning to allow equal access to the site that is held to be holy by Muslims, Jews, and Christians. 302 This would mean recognizing that all faiths should be allowed to have access to and pray on the Temple Mount, as well as allowing them to celebrate their respective religious festivals and observances. This is exactly what was called for in the Peace to **Prosperity** plan that was approved by both the U.S. and Israel.³⁰³ Soon after, Jews began to be allowed to pray openly and to be given access through gates that normally were only open to Muslims.³⁰⁴ This was followed up by the first legal decision of the courts declaring that it was not illegal for Jews to pray on the Temple Mount.³⁰⁵ While not explicit in Scripture, one of the necessary preconditions for restoring sacrifices is the ability to pray openly on the Temple Mount....but with all the preparations that have been made, there is good reason to believe that this prophecy will soon be fulfilled literally. It may not be a return to full sacrificial services, with the slaughter of thousands of animals, but some form of priestly sacrifice could once again be seen in Israel." [Emphasis added] (Widener, pp. 307-8)

But doesn't the Temple need to be rebuilt in order to have animal sacrifices? Not necessarily. In an article that can be downloaded from our website, the Sanhedrin are citing Donald Trump's Israel-Palestine peace plan and claim that it gives them the authority and approval to begin reinstating sacrifices on the Temple Mount. It's entitled: *Thanks to Trump: Pascal Lamb Could Be Sacrificed on*

Temple Mount for the First Time in 2,000 Years. This fascinating article is located under the Supplemental Articles for our book: Daniel's Prophecies Unsealed.

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The Sanhedrin has constructed at emporary altar that can be transported to the Temple Mount and then removed once the ceremony has been completed. Rabbi Weiss, the Sanhedrin spokesman has said:

"The only thing preventing the Jewish people from performing the Passover Sacrifices is the Israeli government."

The sacrifices mentioned in Daniel 9:27 do n ot require an actual rebuilt Temple. The sacrifices only require an altar that is built to adhere to Biblical requirements. The Sanhedrin has already constructed such a structure that is ready to be put into use! With a new Israeli government scheduled to be put in place later in 2022, perhaps the new government will be friendly towards the Sanhedrin and allow them to perform the sacrifice at the Temple Mount on their temporary altar.

Abomination of Desolation

In Appendix 2, we listed the four cases where the term: Abomination of Desolation is used in the book of Daniel. The last case mentioned has to do with the Antichrist appearing on the Temple Mount at the beginning of the *great tribulation*.

5) Therefore when you see the <u>abomination of desolation</u>, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, <u>standing in the holy place</u> (whoever reads, let him understand)...21) For then there will be <u>great tribulation</u>, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be. (Matthew 24:15, 21)

This warning was given by our Lord just before His crucifixion. He was warning the Church of the Antichrist who the Apostle Paul also warned us about in 2 Thessalonians 2:3-4.

Notice that Jesus tells us that he will be standing in the holy place. Some have taken this to mean that he is standing in the Temple, but Dr. Christian Widener's take may be more accurate:

"We might consider, however, that the references to the Antichrist standing in the "temple" and causing the abomination of desolation, mentioned in Matthew 24 and 2 Thessalonians 2, might simply refer to **the Temple Mount area** and not a rebuilt structure. In the book of Acts, we read that the disciples were meeting daily in the temple (*hieron* - Strong's G2411).

This word applies broadly to mean a temple and its entire designated area, so it is often translated "temple courts" because the context makes it clear that they were not in the temple building itself, but in the Temple Mount complex, or the courts of the temple.

When we read the passages in Acts 2:46 and 5:25 that describe believers in the temple (*hieron*) it is understood that the whole area, including the courts and the temple building, was included.

However, when Paul wrote in 2 Thessalonians 2:4 that the man of lawlessness would set "himself up in God's temple, proclaiming himself to be God," he used a different word, naos (Strong's G3485), which specifically refers to the innermost holy place of a temple building itself.

However, the Dome of the Spirits stands over the area that was once the threshing floor of Araunah, where the *holy of holies* of the **temple** once sat.³¹⁷ If the Antichrist made his declaration of being God while standing at or near this spot on the Temple Mount, then I would say that this could also satisfy the grammatical usage of the word *naos*, without a building."[Emphasis added] (Widener, pp. 313-15)



In Dr. Christian Widener's first book: *The Temple Revealed*, he discovered the true location of the Temple. His painstaking research showed that the holy of holies of the Temple once stood where the Dome of the Spirits is located as shown in the photographs on the facing page, as well as the back cover of this book.

This area is north of the Dome of the Rock and it is the area where a future Temple could be rebuilt without disturbing that area. More likely, it may be the location where the Antichrist will come to hold a press conference to publicly declare that he is taking over control of the world because he is god (Daniel 9:27 and 2 Thessalonians 2:4).

Jesus Laments Over Jerusalem

³⁷ O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, who kills the prophets and stones those sent to her, how often I have longed to gather your children together, as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, but you were unwilling! ³⁸ Look, *your house* is left to you desolate. ³⁹ For I tell you that you will not see Me again until you say, 'Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord. *e' e* ³⁹ Psalm 118:26 (Matthew 23:37-39 – BSB)

Just before Jesus was about to be crucified He lamented over Jerusalem. The religious leaders had turned the Temple from a house of God to "your house" because the Jews had made it a den of robbers (Matthew 21:13). Because of this, Jesus said it would be desolate, which was fulfilled when Titus destroyed the city in 70 AD.

Much of the drama in *The Final Countdown* has centered around one of the most valued pieces of real estate in the world. The Temple Mount will become center stage once again as events during these closing years come to their final conclusion.

After the desolation of Jerusalem in 70 A D, Sultan Suleiman was given a dream that he was to rebuild the walls of Jerusalem and beautify the Temple Mount. Suleiman the Magnificent was God's chosen vessel to fulfill Isaiah's prophecy of rebuilding God's Holy City of Jerusalem. In 1537 he issued his decree that was placed on the Temple Mount (preserved in stone) for future generations to see.

The *Peace to Prosperity* plan was issued in January 2020 along with the *Abraham Accords* in September 2020. These covenants occurred 483 years (69 Weeks x 7) after Suleiman's decree in 1537. The final Seven Years may have begun in 2020, which will culminate with Jesus Christ returning in 2027. In this Second Fulfillment of the Seventy Weeks of Daniel, the world will witness the Antichrist making his appearance on the Temple Mount. This will begin the final 3 ½ years of Great Tribulation:

5) Therefore when you see the <u>abomination of desolation</u>, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, <u>standing in the holy place</u> (whoever reads, let him understand)...21) For then there will be <u>great tribulation</u>, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be. (Matthew 24:15, 21)

The good news is that Jesus will be coming back at the end of this time to restore this fallen world. Now is the time to prepare ourselves and help others prepare. As Jesus warns in the above verse, the time of the *great tribulation* will be unlike any other time since the world began. We don't want to be here when that time arrives. Jesus does provide a way of escape for those *blameless* believers (2 Peter 3:14) who are ready when the time arrives.

Jesus told us that we should be praying to be accounted worthy to escape the time that is coming.

34) And take heed to yourselves, lest at anytime your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and so that day come upon you unawares. 35) For as a snare shall it come on all them that dwell on the face of the whole earth. 36) Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of Man. (Luke 21:34-36 – KJV)

The faithful, overcomer heeds the Lord's advice and continually *prays for deliverance* from the coming Tribulation period.

Food for Thought - Possible Interpretation of Daniel 12:11

Daniel's final vision ends by giving several counts of days that have remained a mystery, which are shrouded by possible mistranslations. Perhaps *the daily* in Daniel 12:11 should have been translated: *the blameless*⁶, and could be paraphrased:

And from the time that the <u>blameless are removed</u>, and the <u>abomination of desolation</u> is set up, there will be 1,290 days.

This may be telling us that the blameless believers are removed to a place of safety away from the horrors of the Great Tribulation that is about to ensnare the world. Soon after the righteous are taken away, the Antichrist will arrive in Jerusalem claiming to be God (*cf.* Mat 24:15; 2Th 2:3-4, 7-8). The overcoming Christians are raptured and the Jewish remnant is taken to their place of safety in the wilderness.

The count of days Daniel recorded is probably meant to provide those living during that time a way of determining how much longer they will need to endure before Jesus Christ returns at His Second Coming.

6) "The daily" could be a cryptic reference to the blameless believers, whose lives are seen by God as daily sacrifices (per Romans 12:1), and that the "taking away" is the rapture of Firstfruit believers (cf. Rev 14:1-5). A friend of our ministry recently noted: "What if 'the-daily', HaTamid (H8548), was incorrectly translated from Aramaic or a scribal error changed the Mem to a D alet and should have been a noun version of HaTamim, from the same root word, meaning the-blameless (H8549) (as a noun, rendered 22 times in NAS)?" This verse could then be paraphrased:

"And from the time that the <u>blameless are removed</u>, and the <u>abomination of desolation</u> is set up, there will be 1,290 days."

A reasonable inference from Daniel 12:11 might be that "the blameless" are taken away and the abomination of desolation is set up at the same time. This may suggest the removal of the blameless believers and then the Antichrist is revealed as Paul told us: "He who now restrains will do so until he is taken out of the way. And then the lawless one will be revealed" (2Th 2:7-8). See pp.102-107 in Calling All Overcomers for more information on the removal of the restrainer.

The Shepherd Boy and the Wolf - An Æsop Fable

A Shepherd Boy tended his master's Sheep near a dark forest not far from the village. Soon he found life in the pasture very dull. All he could do to amuse himself was to talk to his dog or play on his shepherd's pipe.

One day as he sat watching the Sheep and the quiet forest, and thinking what he would do should he see a Wolf, he thought of a plan to amuse himself.

His Master had told him to call for help should a Wolf attack the flock, and the Villagers would drive it away. So now, though he had not seen anything that even looked like a Wolf, he ran toward the village shouting at the top of his voice, "Wolf! Wolf!"

As he expected, the Villagers who heard the cry dropped their work and ran in great excitement to the pasture. But when they got there they found the Boy doubled up with laughter at the trick he had played on them. A few days later the Shepherd Boy again shouted, "Wolf! Wolf!" Again the Villagers ran to help him, only to be laughed at again.

Then one evening as the sun was setting behind the forest and the shadows were creeping out over the pasture, a Wolf really did spring from the underbrush and fall upon the Sheep.

In terror, the Boy ran toward the village shouting "Wolf!" But though the Villagers heard the cry, they did not run to help him as they had before. "He cannot fool us again," they said.

The Wolf killed a great many of the Boy's sheep and then slipped away into the forest.



So many dates have been set for the Lord's return that most people scoff whenever a new prognostication is made. As in the fable of the boy who cried, "Wolf," the real danger lies when the correct prediction is ignored and it actually proves to be true. The purpose of *The Final Countdown* has not been to set dates. Its main purpose has been to reveal that Daniel's prophecy has a *Final Decree* that everyone missed, and it is about to be fulfilled. As outlined in the **Preface**, the wise and faithful servant will know the time when the Lord returns and not be taken by surprise. The Second Fulfillment of Daniel's Seventy Weeks is almost finished. What if this book is not a false alarm?

Appendix 4 – Abraham Accords



Ever since Joe Biden took office we have witnessed how his administration has dismantled many of the major accomplishments that President Donald J. Trump achieved. The one major feature Joe Biden did not destroy was the important Abraham Accords. On the contrary, he actually welcomed the Accords and in his trip in July 2022, he even commended Saudi Arabia's recent historic decision of lifting the restrictions on all air carriers from using its airspace.

One of the major (behind the scenes) architects of the Abraham Accords was Jared Kushner who was President Donald J. Trump's key draftsmen and negotiator. His talents as President Trump's senior advisor helped broker four historic peace agreements that prior Presidents were unable to achieve. His successful negotiation of the Abraham Accords was the most significant diplomatic breakthrough in fifty years and earned him a nomination for the Nobel Peace Prize.

In Jared Kushner's recent book: *Breaking History* he provides us with distinctive evidence that God's hand was at work in bringing together several of Israel's neighbors to the peace table. 2020 was a momentous year when the course of history was changed. Kushner's enthralling account provides us with a clear demonstration of God's divine hand as He intervened in history. The important peace accords that were made with many nations marked 2020 as the start of the final 70th Week in the Second Fulfillment of Daniel's Seventy Weeks prophecy. These covenants occurred 483 years (69 Weeks x 7) after Sultan Suleiman's decree in 1537. The final Seven Years began in 2020, with the signing of these notable peace covenants.

If anyone has any doubts about this or thinks that this book is another false alarm, they should read Jared Kushner's remarkable book. God's hand was clearly at work in fashioning the peace covenants outlined in the Abraham Accords.

Year of Jubilee



There are at least two references in Scripture that point us to Jubilee Years. The first one was found by rabbis who connected Ezekiel 40:1 with Leviticus 25:9-10. As noted by Dr. Widener: "The Talmud records their opinion that the twenty-fifth year after the first exile there was a jubilee year, because only in the Year of Jubilee does the New Year (Rosh Hashanah) begin on the tenth of Tishri...with the date of the first exile beginning on 2 Adar 597 BC, there was a Year of Jubilee that began on 10 Tishri 574 BC in the twenty-fifth year of their exile (Ezekiel 40:1)." (Widener, pp. 265-266)

The other Scripture that describes a Jubilee Year was when Jesus began His ministry and He visited a synagogue on the Sabbath where He read from the scroll of Isaiah. This was recorded for us by Luke:

The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor, He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to set the oppressed free, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor.

(Luke 4:18-19)

Jesus then stopped reading and said, "Today, this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing." What He had just read included proclaiming the Year of the Lord's favor (which means a **Year of Jubilee**), which He said was just fulfilled. From this, we can conclude that when Jesus began His ministry in AD 27, He proclaimed that it was a Jubilee Year.

574 BC
$$\longleftrightarrow$$
 27 AD \longleftrightarrow 2027
12 Jubilees 40 Jubilees

By connecting these two Jubilee Years (574 BC and 27 AD) we can extrapolate 40 Jubilees (40 x 50 = 2,000 years), which takes us to the Jubilee Year in 2027. Remember that **Jesus** spent 40 days in the wilderness after He was baptized, and the **Israelites** wandered in the wilderness for 40 years. Are these foreshadowing Jesus would provide for 40 Jubilees – one Jubilee for each day that He spent in the wilderness? And, as believers, aren't we just **pilgrims** in the wilderness on the earth (for a period of 40 Jubilees) looking for our heavenly city? (Hebrews 11:13,16, 1 Peter 2:9-11) Even so, come Lord Jesus!

Appendix 5 – Signs of Christ's Coming



Many modern Bible teachers and students believe that the rebirth of the nation of Israel represents the budding of the *fig tree* that Jesus described to His disciples as He sat on the Mount of Olives, and we are living in the generation that won't pass away before He returns.

Verily I say unto you, this generation shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled. (Matthew 24:34 – KJV)

With Israel becoming a nation in 1948, we have been alerted that the Lord's return is fast approaching. Jesus also told his disciples a second sign to look for in the parable of Noah:

As it was in the days of Noah, so it will be at the coming of the Son of Man. (Matthew 24:37 – NIV)

Here the Lord is telling the Church that just before His return, things will be the same as they were back in Noah's day. This pictures life going on right up until the day that the rapture occurs, and the judgments of God are suddenly released upon the earth. A careful study of Genesis 6 will alert the reader to the fact that living in these end times is almost parallel to the time before the flood. The world has become a great cesspool of corruption, violence, sex, drugs, idolatry, witchcraft and other perversions. Reading the account in Genesis is like reading today's newspaper or listening to the daily news.

In the Lord's parable concerning Noah, Jesus was also giving us a second important sign that His return is drawing very near. Several years ago a famous comet passed through our solar system and it was hailed as the most-watched comet of all time.

"What's that point of light above the World Trade Center? It's Comet Hale-Bopp! Both faster than a speeding bullet and able to "leap" tall buildings in its single orbit, Comet Hale-Bopp is also bright enough to be seen even over the glowing lights of one of the world's premier cities. In the foreground lies the East River, while much of New York City's Lower Manhattan can be seen between the river and the comet."

As it was in the days of Noah, so it will be at the coming of the Son of Man.

(Matthew 24:37 – NIV)

These words from our wonderful Lord have several applications about the Tribulation period that is about to ensnare this world.

Seas Lifted Up

Throughout the Old Testament, the time of the coming Tribulation period is described as the time when the "seas have lifted up," and also as coming in as a "flood" (please see Jeremiah 51:42, Hosea 5:10, Daniel 11:40 and Psalm 93:3-4 for just a few examples).

This is a direct parallel to the time of Noah when the Great Flood of water came to wipe out every living creature except for righteous Noah and his family, and the pairs of animals God spared. While God said He would never flood the earth again with water, the coming Judgement will be by fire (II Peter 3:10). The book of Revelation shows that approximately three billion people will perish in the terrible time that lies ahead (see Revelation 6:8 and 9:15).

2 Witnesses

A guiding principle of God is to establish a matter based upon the witness of two or more:

...a matter must be established by the testimony of two or three witnesses (Deuteronomy 19:15 – NIV)

In 1994, God was able to get the attention of mankind when Comet Shoemaker-Levy crashed into Jupiter on the 9th of Av (on the Jewish calendar). Interestingly, this Comet was named after the "two" witnesses who first discovered it.

In 1995, "two" more astronomers also discovered another comet. It was called Comet Hale-Bopp, and it reached its closest approach to planet Earth on M arch 23, 1997. It has been labeled as the most widely viewed comet in the history of mankind.

Scientists have determined that Comet Hale-Bopp's orbit brought it to our solar system 4,465 years ago (see Notes 1 and 2 below). In other words, the comet made its appearance near Earth in 1997 and also in 2468 BC. Remarkably, this comet preceded the Great Flood by 120 years! God warned Noah of this in Genesis 6:3:

My Spirit shall not strive with man forever, for he is indeed flesh; yet his days shall be one hundred and twenty years.


Days of Noah

What does all of this have to do with the Lord's return? Noah was born around 2948 BC, and Genesis 7:11 tells us that the Flood took place when Noah was 600, or in 2348 BC.

Remember, our Lord told us: "As it was in the days of Noah, so it will be at the coming of the Son of Man.
(Matthew 24:37 – NIV)

In the original Greek, it is saying: "exactly like" it was, so it will be when He comes (see Strong's #5618).

During the days of Noah, Comet Hale-Bopp arrived on the scene as a harbinger of the Great Flood. Just as this same comet appeared before the Flood, could its arrival again in 1997 be a sign that God's final Judgement, also known as the time of Jacob's Trouble, is about to begin?



Comet Hale-Bopp arrived 120 years before the Flood as a warning to mankind. Only righteous Noah heeded God's warning and built the ark, as God instructed. By faith, Noah was obedient to God and, as a result, saved himself and his family from destruction.

Remember, Jesus told us His return would be preceded by great heavenly signs: "And there shall be signs in the sun, and in the moon, and in the stars; and upon the earth distress of nations, with perplexity; the sea and the waves roaring..." (Luke 21:25)

Jesus was asked 3 questions by the disciples: "Tell us, (1) when shall these things be" (the destruction of the city of Jerusalem), "and (2) what shall be the <u>sign</u> of thy coming, and (3) of the end of the world?" (Matthew 24:3)

Just as this large comet appeared as a 120-year warning to Noah, its arrival in 1997 tells us that Jesus is getting ready to return again. Is this the "Sign" Jesus referred to?

Sign of Christ's Coming

The **first** question had to do with events that were fulfilled in 70 AD. The **third** question has to do with the future time at the very end of the age.

The **second** question, however, has to do with the time of Christ's second coming. Jesus answered this second question in His description of the days of Noah found in Matthew 24:33-39:

37 But as the days of Noe were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. (38) For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark, (39) And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.

Jesus is telling us that the <u>sign</u> of His coming will be as it was during the days of Noah. As Comet Hale-Bopp was a sign to the people in Noah's day, its arrival in 1997 is a sign that Jesus is coming back again soon. Comet Hale-Bopp could be the <u>very sign</u> Jesus was referring to, which would announce His return for His faithful.

Remember, Jesus said, "exactly as it was in the days of Noah, so will it be when He returns." The appearance of Comet Hale-Bopp in 1997 is a strong indication that the Tribulation period is about to begin, but before then, Jesus is coming for His bride!

Keep looking up! Jesus is coming again very soon!

As Noah prepared for the destruction God warned him about 120 years before the Flood, Jesus has given mankind a final warning that the Tribulation period is about to begin. The horrible destruction on 9/11 is only a precursor of what is about to take place on planet Earth. We need to be wise like Noah and prepare. Always remember our Lord's instructions in Luke 21:34-36:

(34)And take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and so that day come upon you unawares. (35) For as a snare shall it come on all them that dwell on the face of the whole earth. (36)Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man (Luke 21:34-36).

Footnotes to Appendix 5

(1) The original orbit of Comet Hale-Bopp was calculated to be approximately 265 years by engineer George Sanctuary in his article, *Three Craters In Israel*, published on 3/31/01 found in the Supplemental Articles for *Coming Spiritual Earthquake*.

Comet Hale-Bopp's orbit around the time of the Flood changed from 265 years to about 4,200 years. Because the plane of the comet's orbit is perpendicular to the earth's orbital plane (ecliptic), Mr. Sanctuary noted: "A negative time increment was used for this simulation...to back the comet away from the earth... past Jupiter... and then out of the solar system. The simulation suggests that the pastpast orbit had a very eccentric orbit with a period of only 265 years. When the comet passed Jupiter (*around 2203BC*) its orbit was deflected upward, coming down near the earth 15 months later with the comet's period changed from 265 years to about (4,200) years." (*added text for clarity*)

(2) Don Yeomans, with NASA's Jet Propulsion Laboratory, made the following observations regarding the comet's orbit: "By integrating the above orbit forward and backward in time until the comet leaves the planetary system and then referring the osculating orbital elements...the following orbital periods result: Original orbital period before entering planetary system

= 4200 years. Future orbital period after exiting the planetary system = 2380 years."

Based upon the above two calculations we have the following:

 $265^{(a)} + 4,200^{(b)} = 4,465 \text{ Years}$

1997 AD - 4,465 Years = 2468 BC = Hale Bopp arrived

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

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


