Many of those ideas overlap and can be condensed into four primary views. In 'The Temple Revealed', Dr. Widener proposes his own view, which is essentially a modification of Asher Kaufman's proposal, which located the Temple in the norther portion of the Temple Mount, with the exception that it must also be in line with the Golden Gate. Dr. Widener presents information and reasoning to demonstrate, beyond a reasonable doubt, that this is the proper location and exposes why other views are untenable in light of the archaeological evidence and weight of historical testimony.

Q. Bottom line, what is the book about and why is it important?

A. This book is about determining the exact location of where the Jewish temple sat before it was destroyed in 70 A.D.B. The reason that question matters is that the Bible clearly predicts that a temple of some type will be rebuilt or setup prior to the return of Christ. The majority popular and scholarly opinion is that the temple was formerly located in the exact spot where the current Islamic shrine, called the Dome of the Rock, now sits in the middle of the Temple Mount. It's unmistakable golden domed roof is now an icon of Jerusalem. If that was true, and the orthodox Jews insist on only rebuilding a temple if it can be rebuilt in the exact spot that God commanded, then it presents quite an obstacle to rebuilding a temple. However, based on a very thorough review of the biblical, historical, and archaeological cases for its location, as well as some new engineering arguments of my own, I think it can now be said with certainty that this is not the case.



Q. So, where was it located and why have so many others missed it?

A. The short answer is that the temple was formerly located in the northern portion of the enclosure, directly in line with the famous Golden Gate in the eastern wall of the Temple Mount which for the past almost 500 years has been literally walled up in stone. Jews, Christians, and Muslims universally identify this as the messianic gate, but nevertheless fail to recognize it as an enduring landmark from the temples of Solomon and Herod. Another thing most scholars failed to recognize was the uncanny precision of alignment of the Golden Gate with another feature on the Temple Mount, which is now marked by the Dome of the Spirits, which was built over it. The dome covers an area of flat and smooth bedrock, approximately ten feet in diameter, which even today would make an excellent threshing floor surface. No other place on the entire 36 acre Temple Mount presents such a perfect example of a likely threshing floor. And get this, I calculated that the probability that the alignment of the Golden Gate with this flat bedrock surface happened by accident is only 0.07%. Or in other words, there is a 99.93% chance that the Golden Gate was aligned with this piece of bedrock on purpose.C. So the essence of my argument is that we can actually identify two landmarks from the temple which can be convincingly tied to the temple, and that together they show its precise former location.

Q. Why you? You're a mechanical engineer, not an archaeologist or historian.

A. Yeah, that's a good question, and I wrestled with that question myself. In many ways, I didn't feel qualified either, which may be part of why I waited more than ten years to start writing the book. But you know what? I'm a really good researcher, and I'm good at figuring out how things work and figuring out how to do things that no one knows how to do yet, things people don't even believe can be done. So I'll say that I'm persistent and thorough, and besides the new arguments that I developed myself, I'm just using the excellent work of scholars, historians, and translators and

reprocessing them to show what they really mean in the big picture. There is a big difference between what a scholar found as documented fact, and how they interpreted those facts and expressed them as scholarly opinion. But overall, I just feel fortunate that God has given me the opportunity to present this information at the present time. I think that anyone who really examines this book with an open mind will see how clear and simple the case really is. I actually don't feel like I've solved something that should have been a mystery. It feels more like I'm the little boy shouting that "the emperor has no clothes!"
