As it was in the beginning, as it is today, the man that pleases God is the man who hears God's Word, believes God's Word and puts faith in his promises.

Abraham was such a man; he heard the Word of God, "BELIEVED IT" and consequently it was counted unto him as righteousness. Genesis records God's "special blessing" to Abraham. Listen carefully to the rich and wonderful WORD given to this humble man on a night long ago: "AFTER THESE THINGS THE WORD OF THE LORD CAME UNTO ABRAM IN A VISION, SAYING FEAR NOT, ABRAM: I AM THY SHIELD, AND THY EXCEEDING GREAT REWARD."

WOW! What a blessing! Any man would be joyful to receive a "reward" from God; or to be told that you were to receive a "great reward." But to be told, "I AM THY SHIELD, AND THY EXCEEDING GREAT REWARD" is truly an overwhelming blessing and honor!

How Abraham must have marveled within himself that night as he looked up into the sky. How his heart must have rejoiced when the Creator urged him to count the stars (if he could) that studded the heavens and to know this rich and vast promise from God belonged to him and his offspring.

Though thousands of years have passed since that stary night long ago - God's WORD remains true. There is an "EXCEEDING GREAT REWARD" promised to those who take "HIS WORD" personally into their hearts and lives. This "WORD" is JESUS: "And the WORD was made flesh, and dwelt among us." (John 1:14a). Faith in HIM is the key that unlocks the door to heaven. By trusting in him, we too can partake of the blessed inheritance that God

promised to Abraham.

The scriptures emphasize that faith comes by hearing and hearing by the WORD of GOD. Abraham heard God speaking to him and he believed! He put faith into his word. He demonstrated his devotion to God's Word and his promise in his daily life. He was more than just a "hearer" - he was a "doer".

We are warned "without faith it is impossible to please God." All true descendants of Father Abraham walk the life of FAITH, trusting in God's Holy Word. The righteous seed know it is the only TRUE and PERFECT path rich with God's promises.

The Old Testament foreshadows the New Testament. God's covenant with his chosen people Israel portrays his redemptive plan: the remission of sin through blood sacrifice Christ, the sinless lamb of God is the fulfillment of that holy sacrifice. The door to eternal life is found in HIM. Rejected by Israel as the "PROMISED MESSIAH", the door of

salvation was opened to the Gentiles. God's New Covenant children were no longer under "law" but "grace". This grace-given gift could not be understood by his "chosen race". Without FAITH in HIS WORD they could not comprehend "Kingdom Mysteries":

"Israel hath not obtained that which he seeketh for; but the election hath obtained it, and the rest were blinded. (According as it is written, God hath given them the spirit of slumber, eyes that they should not see, and ears that they should not hear;) unto this day." (Romans 11:7&8)

God's chosen people have been rejected (for a season) because they rejected HIS plan of salvation. They became so wise in their own eyes, they could not see his plan or hear his word. They became a people void of real FAITH! Their hardened hearts kept them from receiving the Heavenly Father's means of redemption.

The New Testament Church is under a very precious period of grace. Though under grace, through Christ's atonement, todays Christians are NOT released from their duty to study "The WORD" and understanding God's Kingdom mysteries. If Israel, God's chosen nation, could fall away from his plan of redemptive grace, how cautious half-hearted Christians should be! God has not changed! He is still a Holy God. A God looking for repentive people; followers humble sensitive to His Word and Holy Spirit. many merely use his precious Son's blood as their spiritual loophole - "saving grace" without true repentance.

With mans free will God has given him the responsibility and power of choosing, rejecting the things of God. Consequently, as with the Old Testament church the New Testament church is held accountable for their comprehension and obedience to the Christ is the Father's "PERFECT" WORD. solution for sin and separation from His presence. Through Christ, a true believer, can come boldly to his throne of grace and help to overcome; help to receive help: understand; help to be ALL he has purposed for those who truly love him. The capacity to "find & know" the Father's perfect will life for his children is hid in Christ. Jesus said only those who do the will of the Father will come into the Kingdom (Mat. 7:21).

Blessed Hope

God gave Abraham a vision. He gave him the ability to foresee the promise of His Word. There is life abundant overflowing from God's Word; an "EXCEEDING GREAT REWARD" promised to those who live by faith and not by sight. It is a heritage with a blessed hope.

"We live by faith, not by sight."
II Corinthians 5:7 NIV



We are told in Proverbs 29:18, "where there is no vision, the people perish." How true this is! A dead church has no true vision of the things of God. A people without ears to hear and eyes to see God's promises, are deaf and blind. These lives, empty of true suffer the God's Word will consequences of their hardened hearts. "BLESSED HOPE" is beyond their grasp spiritu-They are a people bound-up with Sadly, when Christ comes for his unbelief. Church, many will be left behind.

Only those Christians who are humbled under the Word can realize or understand the "WAYS" of the Lord; for his path is holy and his way is pure. The righteous find this path only through yielding to the Holy Ghost, receiving the Blessed Hope as a reward for their own obedience. Those who are disobedient will not have this Hope and miss God's best.

Old Testament Examples

The Pharisees & Scribes strictly observed and interpreted the Jewish law. Their life of traditions and customs gave an outward appearance of holiness. However devout and earnestly religious these people appeared to themselves and others, THEY WERE NOT PLEASING TO GOD. They were hypocrites. Their hearts were far away from him. When Jesus exposed them for what they truly were His disciples came to him saying, "Knowest thou that the

Pharisees were offended, after they heard this saying? But he answered and said, every plant, which my Heavenly Father hath not planted, shall be rooted up. Let them alone: They be blind leaders of the blind. the blind lead the blind, both shall fall into the ditch" (Matthew 15:12-14). Further on he also rebuked their very diligent tithing practices. "Woe unto you, Scribes and Pharisees, Hypocrites! For ye pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier matters of the law, judgement, mercy, and faith: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone." (Matt. 23:23). He continues on, "even so ye also outwardly appear righteous unto men, but within ye are full of hypocrisy and iniquity" (Matthew 23:28).



Every plant that God TRULY PLANTS grows! His seed is good seed that thrives in good soil. The good heart, the repentive heart receives the WORD with gladness. That little seed, so precious, is nourished & developed through constant prayer and meditation on His Word. With blessed FAITH in Christ hidden away, deep in the humble heart, a divine transformation begins to occur. dying process (germination - breaking) transpires and soon little roots reach out deeper into the rich soil (God's Word). When the time is right a little blade forms and begins to shoot forth and become clearly visible to the eye: "So is the Kingdom of God, as if a man should cast seed into the ground; and should sleep, and rise night and day, and the seed should spring and grow up, he knoweth not how" (Mark 4:26).

Such is the Kingdom of God, be ye Jew or Gentile. If it is within you, the good seed WILL NOT remain dormant. Though hidden away for a time - it will manifest itself. In a truly good and humble heart new birth becomes evident. The Christian who sincerely loves and knows Jesus as Lord will display the fruits of His sweet spirit - it will be very obvious to all.

How truly sad it is that so many born-again Christians do not KNOW or UNDERSTAND these truths. When Jesus spoke of the parable of the sower (Mark 4) he said unto them, "know ye not this parable?" If this parable is misunderstood then it is fair to say ALL OTHER PARABLES that Christ spoke about will never be properly comprehended. Only a sincere follower will understand God's truth.

Jesus tells his disciples, "Unto you it is given to know the mystery of the Kingdom of God: but unto them that are without, all of these things are done in parables: that seeing they may see, and not perceive; and hearing they may hear, and not understand; lest at any time they should be converted, and their sins should be forgiven them."

(Mark 4:11 & 12)

Good seed is the "GOOD NEWS", the WORD of GOD - JESUS. Just because good seed (the message of Christ and the salvation found only in him) lands "into" or "on top of" or "around" listening hearts, without real and genuine faith IN HIM and constant trust and commitment to his word, the good seed will NEVER germinate or perfectly grow and thrive.

So many false Christians have unfavorable heart conditions that will not and do not truly know Christ as their PERSONAL Lord and Savior. They are tares among the wheat, too blind and spiritually unaware to even recognize their own wretched state. But even more alarming is the condition of many true Christians. Jesus admonishes them:

"Not every one that saith to me Lord, Lord, shall enter into the Kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven" (Matthew 7:21).

Satan has duped insincere hearts into thinking a confession of faith in Christ, without repentance assures them of receiving God's rich blessings and heritage.

If one has indeed been saved by grace through faith in the Lord Jesus Christ, God's Holy Kingdom which is founded on truth and righteousness will manifest itself in the life of the faithful believer. Every good tree bears good fruit; that's the long and short of it! There is no in-between. He is the vine, we are the branches. Every branch that doesn't bear holy fruit will be cut off and many real Christians will end up missing the Kingdom.

LITTLE FAITH = BIG FAITH

Even Christs' disciples anxious for outwardly visible, divine manifestations of faith, were When they focusing in the wrong direction. asked the Lord to increase or give them MORE faith, they were in essence, looking for a Jesus responded to their request short cut. through the parable of the mustard seed. This tiny seed, insignificant among others would in time, become the largest of trees with a spectacular future. This striking advancement will come. for there is a process involved. Though it may appear as if it is slow in coming or that performing ones duty (obedience to the word) is unprofitable - IT WILL BE rewarded. To those who REMAIN IN THE WORD, a mature and holy faith will develop; yielding an outward manifestation of God's divine presence - SUCH IS THE KINGDOM OF GOD.

At the proper time, the appointed time, every good and pure servant shall eat from God's bountiful table. Each vessel of God will be honored with His rich & anointed goodness. To the responsible and faithful steward HIS promotion will come and when it does, it will be a perfect and holy work.

Prodigal = Bride of Christ



JOYFUL ANTICIPATION



FOR WHERE YOUR TREASURE IS YOUR HEART WILL BE ALSO."



Sadly, the vast majority of Christ's church is more concerned with their earthly treasure and the present kingdom on the earth. Even a review of the leading prophecy ministries will bare this out. Christians are concerned more about their finances and the coming economic earthquake, but care very little about the coming spiritual earthquake. Most fail to realize what God's Word says:

"You MUST teach what is in accord with sound doctrine" (Titus 2:1).

"Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth" (Rev.3:10).

Keeping God's Word & upholding sound doctrine go hand-in-hand. Sound doctrine MUST be taught, and God's Word MUST be kept. The wonderful promise of escaping the "hour of temptation" is given to those Christians who are keeping God's Word. This includes upholding and teaching "sound doctrine."

This is only right because Jesus is the Word. If we really love Jesus, we will want to keep His Word and teach what is in accordance with sound doctrine.

Lukewarm Laodiceans
