WHO REALLY COMPOSED THE POEM "THE BRIDE"?

Lord, I cannot help but think about your parable in Matthew 25, about the wise and foolish virgins. I am trying to be wise and study. I am trying to be led by YOUR SPIRIT. I do not understand why everything I have been working on concerning this article is not coming together properly! Will you PLEASE help me, Lord?"

As I sat quietly at my desk, I felt the Lord in a very gentle, loving way begin to speak to my heart. I heard Him in my spirit, through prayer and what He told me

that night CHANGED MY PERSPECTIVE, regarding many THINGS about HIS WORK.

As I bowed before Him, I heard the Holy Spirit instruct me to pick up my pen and look at it. As I did, I noticed it was almost EMPTY and I remembered it was a brand new BIC pen when I initially began working on this study. I looked at the pages of material that had been written and I felt the Lord tell me, "I want to teach you a special lesson about the wise and foolish virgins. THIS IS what I want you to give to my people." Well, needless to say, I LISTENED since I had finally gotten His attention, OR should I say HE HAD GOTTEN MINE!

With that instruction and the minuscule amount of ink left in the cartridge – the poel about the 5 wise and 5 foolish virgins flowed onto my paper without hesitation. After HE GAVE IT TO ME, I read it and trembled before God! (WOULDN'T YOU?) He said, "In a matter of seconds and with a very small amount of ink and effort, I HAVE GIVEN YOU A MESSAGE that will travel across the land.
